On May 2, 2006, the Council adopted Resolution No. 6879 adopting the Public Service Ethics Program For City Officials developed by the Scottsdale Citizens Code of Ethics Task Force; and, Ordinance No. 3675 amending the Scottsdale Revised Code to add a Code of Ethical Behavior for City Officers and making the Code of Ethical Behavior applicable to members of City boards and commissions.
