Cause for Interpretation:

Within Section 7.602.3 the Zoning Ordinance requires lights to be shielded and use shielding. Although, the Zoning Ordinance does not define what shielding is.

Interpretation:

Shielding, lighting shall mean internal or external louvers system, visors, or shields as an integral part of the luminaire that conceal the lamp and/or lamp source from being seen from the property line.
