6. Prohibit the use by or sale of fireworks to persons under the age of eighteen;
7. Require sellers of permissible consumer fireworks within the City to post signs indicating City restrictions wherever fireworks are displayed for sale; and
8. Declare an emergency for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.



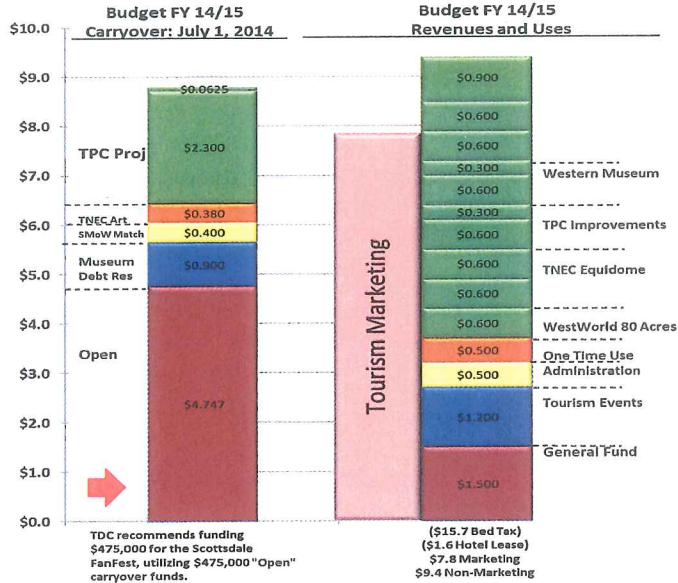

## Super Bowl 2008 Economic Impact

- In 2008, Super Bowl XLII resulted in **\$500M** in economic impact to Arizona.
- Over Super Bowl weekend (Jan.31 – Feb.4), Scottsdale and Paradise Valley realized significant increases in hotel occupancy and rate
  - Hotel room Average Daily Rate (ADR) was **\$410.31** vs. **\$267.36** - **54%** higher than the rest of the valley.

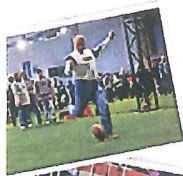

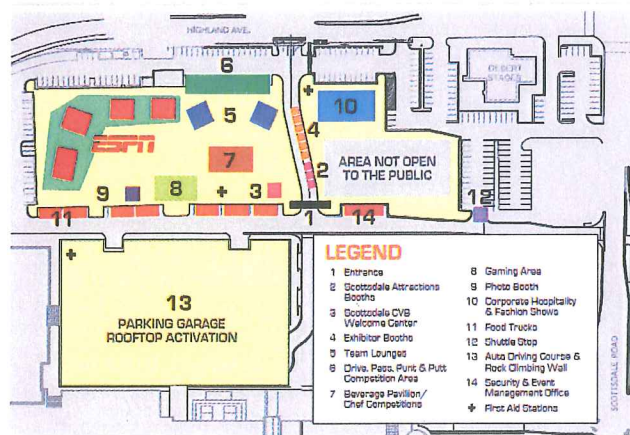

On April 29, 2014, I presented information that Black Mountain Sewer Corporation, aka Liberty Water, has been billing approximately 1000 homes in Scottsdale's Winfield and South Boulders communities for treating our wastewater, even though Scottsdale actually receives and provides this treatment. This has resulted in these Scottsdale residents paying one of the highest sewer rates in the state (currently \$65.36/month, soon to go to \$80.36/month), most of which goes into the pockets of a now Canadian Company.

While the Black Mountain Sewer Corporation has a treatment plant located in the Boulders in Carefree, this treatment plant does not process our wastewater. It does process wastewater from about 2000 Carefree homes and businesses and it has been ordered to be closed by the Arizona Corporation Commission. When this occurs, Black Mountain Sewer Corporation will not have any treatment facilities in this area.

This raises several additional areas where Scottsdale needs to be involved. What will happen to the current wastewater being treated by this plant? Will it go to Scottsdale, Cave Creek or another treatment facility? This plant also supplies the two Boulders golf courses with reclaimed water, resulting in a law suit against this closing. Would Scottsdale want to receive this wastewater and supply the Boulders Golf courses?

This Petition, signed by 592 Winfield homeowners, is asking for Mayor Lane and the City Council to please direct City staff to work with us (the Scottsdale residents in Winfield, the South Boulders, and the future homeowners and businesses that will be located on Scottsdale land, still currently assigned to Black Mountain Sewer Corporation, adjacent to Winfield & the South Boulders along Scottsdale Road) through this process of closing this plant and to eventually take control of our wastewater and billing from the Black Mountain Sewer Corporation via the Arizona Corporation Commission. I'm Bob Cappel, 33600 N. 79<sup>th</sup> Way, Scottsdale, and I'm here tonight as the President of the Winfield Homeowners Association. Winfield is a gated community of 511 homes on the south side of Westland Road between Scottsdale and Hayden Roads. As Scottsdale residents, the homeowners of Winfield homes, along with the homeowners of approximately 500 homes in the Scottsdale South Boulders area and of the 40 new Boulders Villa homes soon to be built on the northeast corner of Westland and Scottsdale Roads, have a difficult situation.

Scottsdale installed our water and sewer lines, provides water, wastewater, trash, and recycling, and bills us for water, trash & recycling. While Scottsdale receives and treats our sewage, we are forced by the Arizona Corporation Commission to pay Black Mountain Sewer Corporation for this service. Each month our homeowners receive a bill from Black Mountain Sewer Corporation for \$65.36, which is soon to go to at least \$80.36/month, by far one of the highest in the state.

Because all of these homes have desert plantings and drip irrigation, the average water usage/home is less than 6,000 gallons/month. If we were all billed by Scottsdale for receiving and treating our sewage, we would pay about \$18/month based on Scottsdale's current billing rate. We know that Black Mountain Sewer Corporation pays Scottsdale about \$36/month for each home to treat our sewage, double the current Scottsdale residential rate. So Black Mountain Sewer Corporation gets to pocket about \$30/month, soon to be \$45/month, for each of our 1000 homes. That's a nice profit of about \$360,000/year, soon to go to \$540,000/year, for simply sending out bills to 1000 homes each month and writing a monthly check to Scottsdale for receiving and treating our sewage.

We are asking the Scottsdale City Government and staff to please work with us, along with the cities of Carefree, Cave Creek, the Boulders Golf Course, and the Arizona Corporation Commission, as we go through the process of closing the Carefree sewage treatment plant to reach the best future solution for all concerned.
