

RESOLUTION NO. 3019

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SCOTTSDALE, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, DECLARING THE OFFICIAL CANVASS OF VOTES CAST IN THE CITY OF SCOTTSDALE PRIMARY ELECTION OF FEBRUARY 16, 1988, DECLARING THE ELECTION OF ONE (1) CANDIDATE FOR THE OFFICE OF MAYOR, DECLARING THE ELECTION OF ONE (1) CANDIDATE FOR THE OFFICE OF COUNCILMAN, DECLARING THE NOMINATION OF FOUR (4) CANDIDATES FOR THE REMAINING OFFICES OF COUNCILMAN IN THE CITY GENERAL ELECTION AND DECLARING THE OFFICIAL CANVASS OF VOTES.

WHEREAS, the Municipal Election of the City of Scottsdale, Arizona was held on February 16, 1988 pursuant to the City Charter, for the purpose of electing a Mayor and three Councilmen of the City of Scottsdale; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Scottsdale, Maricopa County, Arizona, having canvassed the returns of said election and find such returns to be stated herein below,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Scottsdale as follows:




