Description: The Civil Service Board was established to provide for the enactment of personnel rules for the personnel of the City of Scottsdale.

Purpose:

From Scottsdale City Charter Article 4., Sec. 5 Civil service system to be established.

The civil service board shall prescribe, amend and enforce rules for the employees of the City, except those elected by the people and excluding all officers and department heads. These rules shall have the effect of law after they have been approved by the City Council.

No bylaws were adopted by the Civil Service Board (Personnel Board). The Hearing Procedures for the Board are not dated.

Ordinance No. 172 was adopted by Council on April 30, 1963, providing for the creation of a Civil Service Board, to be known as the Scottsdale Personnel Board. The first appointments were made on June 5, 1962, prior to the adoption of the ordinance creating the board. Early appointments were made to the Civil Service Board, rather than the Scottsdale Personnel Board, despite the ordinance language stating the board would be called the Scottsdale Personnel Board.

Also on April 30, 1963, the Council passed Resolution No. 253, which adopted the personnel system rules and regulations of the City of Scottsdale by reference.
