3) Energy and Green Construction Code Updates

Commissioner Cuculic made a motion for Commissioner Cuculic to represent the Commission as a backup to Chair Chrisman Lazarr at the August 23, 2022, City Council Work Study Session, with Commissioner Johnson providing a Second for the motion, which carried 5-0. All members present voted for APPROVAL.

Commissioner Johnson made a motion for Chair Chrisman Lazarr to represent the Commission on the topic of building code updates at any other City Council meetings through September 21, 2022, with Commissioner Cuculic as a backup, with Vice Chair Coletta providing a Second for the motion, which carried 5-0. All members present voted for APPROVAL.
