JESUS MURILLO DISCUSSED ROBERT'S RULES AND GAVE PACKET CONTAINING LIST OF ROBERT'S RULES. COMMISSIONERS DISCUSSED AND GAVE DIRECTION TO STAFF AS THE COMMISSION UPDATED THE HPC WORK PROGRAM. COMMISSIONERS DISCUSSED OUTREACH PROGRAM TO MAKE MORE HISTORIC PRESERVATION HOME AND **BUILDING OWNERS AWARE OF THE HISTORIC SIGNIFICANCE OF THEIR** PROPERTY.
