The Board will also discuss and take possible action to determine the process for communicating the Board's recommendation to the City Council, including making a

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presentation to the City Council and/or being available to answer questions, regarding its recommendation on Judge Blake's reappointment.

Action: Formal motion and vote on recommendation to the City Council regarding reappointment. Discussion, possible motion and vote or direction to staff regarding communicating the Board's recommendation to the City Council.

9. <u>TIMELINE FOR JUDGE JOSEPH OLCAVAGE'S AND JUDGE STATIA HENDRIX'S JUDICIAL REAPPOINTMENTS</u>

HR staff will discuss the judicial reappointment timelines for Judge Joseph Olcavage and Judge Statia Hendrix whose current terms expire on March 9, 2018 to include the possibility of direction by the JAAB for separate or combined processes.
