### **REGULAR MEETING AGENDA**

#### 1. Friends of Scottsdale Public Library Update

Trey Granger, President of the Friends of Scottsdale Public Library, gave a presentation outlining the group's official goals for the 2021 calendar year.

Official goals of the Friends of Scottsdale Public Library for 2021 include:

- 1. Increase membership to 100 members
- 2. Raise \$60,000 in new funds
- 3. Increase the number of Board Members from 11 to 15 members

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- 4. Host three member-inclusive events in addition to Spirit of Literacy Awards
- 5. Increase followers on the Friends' Facebook and Twitter pages by 50 percent

## 2. Annual Report

Kira Peters, Library Director, presented the 2020 Annual Report, noting that it consists of a review of agenda topics covered throughout the year. Her presentation included a review of anticipated key issues, future significant work projects, and upcoming opportunities, challenges and outcomes.

Board Members were given an opportunity to ask questions. Director Peters said that at this time there is not a ZOOM Storytime equivalent. However, virtual Storytime programming is available through Facebook and YouTube. In response to a question about how members of the community with special needs are being serviced, Director Peters noted that the library offers home-delivery service and the City has an active Adaptive Services Department. Ms. Galligan-Butler said that although Braille books are not available through Scottsdale public libraries, they are available through other organizations in the County. Scottsdale libraries do offer audio books and audio e-materials for the convenience of those who are sight-impaired.

Director Peters said that staff is working on marketing materials to educate the public about finefree at the library.

### 3. Patron Comment Report

Director Peters said that staff is redacting personal information from the patron comment reports now that they are available through the ZOOM meetings.

Director Peters mentioned that the patron comments included requests to extend reduced computer use. She explained that due to COVID, the one-hour limit will remain in an effort to discourage group gathering. Staff is evaluating ways to reopen Mustang Library with limited attendance. Harsh language that was pointed out in library notices has been amended.
