1. Review and approval of regular session meeting minutes – April 15, 2021

BOARD MEMBER BROWN MOVED TO APPROVE AS PRESENTED THE REGULAR SESSION MEETING MINUTES FROM THE APRIL 15, 2021 PSPRS POLICE LOCAL BOARD MEETING. BOARD MEMBER PALIWODA SECONDED THE MOTION, WHICH CARRIED FOUR (4) TO ZERO (0) BY ROLL CALL VOTE. CHAIR MERAZ, BOARD MEMBERS BROWN, PALIWODA, AND HEEREN VOTED IN THE AFFIRMATIVE. THERE WERE NO DISSENTING VOTES.

2. Induction of new City of Scottsdale Police officers into PSPRS, if any

BOARD MEMBER PALIWODA MOVED TO APPROVE THE INDUCTION OF NEW SCOTTSDALE POLICE OFFICER RECRUIT ALEXANDER ROMERO WITH AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF MARCH 29, 2021. HE WILL BE INDUCTED WITH PRE-EXISTING MEDICAL CONDITIONS, IF ANY, AS NOTED ON THE LISTING THAT IS INCLUDED WITH THE BOARD PACKET. BOARD MEMBER HEEREN SECONDED THE MOTION, WHICH CARRIED FOUR (4) TO ZERO (0) BY ROLL CALL VOTE. CHAIR MERAZ, BOARD MEMBERS BROWN, PALIWODA, AND HEEREN VOTED IN THE AFFIRMATIVE. THERE WERE NO DISSENTING VOTES.

3. Discussion and vote on the Deferred Retirement Option Plan (DROP) application of Police Officer Matthew T. Miller

Ms. Sampson noted that Police Officer Matthew T. Miller entered the DROP on April 10, 2021 with 22.039 years of service. His monthly benefit is \$4,376.29. All of his paperwork is in order.

Ms. Sampson noted that Police Officer John Garry Miller retired May 1, 2021 with 26.029 years of service. His monthly benefit is \$5,176.18. All of his paperwork is in order.

5. Discussion and vote on the Deferred Retirement Option Plan (DROP) termination and Normal Retirement Application of Police Officer Scott S. Carpenter

Ms. Sampson noted that Police Officer Scott S. Carpenter retired on May 6, 2021 with 25.140 years of service. His monthly benefit is \$5,787.78. All of his paperwork is in order.
