Ms. Sampson announced that she is leaving her position with the City and Ms. Asmus will replace her as the Board secretary.

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BOARD MEMBER SPRINGBORN MOVED TO APPROVE THE APPOINTMENT OF AUTUMN ASMUS AS THE PSPRS FIRE LOCAL BOARD SECRETARY. BOARD MEMBER CAVNER SECONDED THE MOTION, WHICH CARRIED THREE (3) TO ZERO (0) BY ROLL CALL VOTE. CHAIR MERAZ, BOARD MEMBERS CAVNER AND SPRINGBORN VOTED IN THE AFFIRMATIVE. THERE WERE NO DISSENTING VOTES.

2. Review and approval of regular session meeting minutes – October 21, 2021

BOARD MEMBER CAVNER MOVED TO APPROVE AS PRESENTED THE REGULAR SESSION MEETING MINUTES FROM THE OCTOBER 21, 2021 PSPRS FIRE LOCAL BOARD MEETING. BOARD MEMBER SPRINGBORN SECONDED THE MOTION, WHICH CARRIED THREE (3) TO ZERO (0) BY ROLL CALL VOTE. CHAIR MERAZ, BOARD MEMBERS CAVNER AND SPRINGBORN VOTED IN THE AFFIRMATIVE. THERE WERE NO DISSENTING VOTES.

3. Induction of new City of Scottsdale Firefighters into PSPRS, if any

4. Discussion and vote on the Accidental Disability Retirement Application of Fire Engineer Chad M. Hopkins

BOARD MEMBER CAVNER MOVED TO APPROVE THE ISSUANCE OF AN INDEPENDENT MEDICAL EXAMINATION THROUGH ONE OF THE BOARD'S CONTRACTED MEDICAL PROVIDERS FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF A MEDICAL SPECIALISTS TO SERVE AS THE MEDICAL BOARD FOR THE ACCIDENTAL DISABILITY RETIREMENT APPLICATION OF FIRE ENGINEER CHAD M. HOPKINS, WITH THE CAVEAT THAT MORE THAN ONE SPECIALIST CAN APPOINTED AS NECESSARY TO EVALUATE ALL ASPECTS OF HIS INJURY. BOARD MEMBER SPRINGBORN SECONDED THE MOTION, WHICH CARRIED THREE (3) TO ZERO (0) BY ROLL CALL VOTE. CHAIR MERAZ, BOARD MEMBERS CAVNER AND SPRINGBORN VOTED IN THE AFFIRMATIVE. THERE WERE NO DISSENTING VOTES.

5. Discussion and vote on the DROP (Deferred Retirement Option Plan) termination and Normal Retirement Application of Fire Captain Jeff R. Perry

Ms. Sampson noted that Fire Captain Jeff R. Perry entered the DROP on October 30, 3016 with 25.002 years of service. He retired on October 29, 2021. His monthly benefit is \$4,968.97. All of his paperwork is in order.

BOARD MEMBER SPRINGBORN SECONDED THE MOTION, WHICH CARRIED THREE (3) TO ZERO (0) BY ROLL CALL VOTE. CHAIR MERAZ, BOARD MEMBERS CAVNER AND SPRINGBORN VOTED IN THE AFFIRMATIVE. THERE WERE NO DISSENTING VOTES.

Chair Meraz thanked Captain Perry for his years of service and wished him a happy retirement.

6. Discussion and vote on the DROP (Deferred Retirement Option Plan) termination and Normal Retirement Application of Fire Chief Deputy James D. Ford

Ms. Sampson noted that Fire Chief Deputy James D. Ford entered the DROP on June 22, 2019 with 20.062 years of service. He will retire on November 29, 2021. His monthly benefit is \$5,812.24. All of his paperwork is in order.
