BOARD MEMBER PALIWODA SECONDED THE MOTION, WHICH CARRIED THREE (3) TO ZERO (0) BY ROLL CALL VOTE. CHAIR MERAZ, BOARD MEMBERS PALIWODA AND HEEREN VOTED IN THE AFFIRMATIVE. THERE WERE NO DISSENTING VOTES.

Chair Meraz thanked Officer Capone for his years of service.

5. Discussion and vote on the DROP (Deferred Retirement Option Plan) Termination and Normal Retirement Application of Police Commander Joseph J. Nichols

Ms. Sampson noted that Police Commander Joseph J. Nichols entered the DROP on August 20, 2020 with 20.589 years of service and retired on November 5, 2021. His monthly benefit is \$5,827.47. All of his paperwork is in order.
