Laurie Coe: HELLO, EVERYBODY. I'M LAURIE COE AND I LIVE AT 9214 EAST WOOD DRIVE, WHICH IS JUST NORTH OF CACTUS AND THE 101. I'VE BEEN A RESIDENT OF ARIZONA FOR OVER 35 YEARS AND NEVER GOTTEN INVOLVED IN CITY POLITICS. NOT TOO LONG AGO, I WAS ABLE TO SERVE ON THE VISIONING BOARD AND I REALLY ENJOYED PARTICIPATING IN THAT, AND WAS SORRY THAT WE TOSSED IT OUT. BUT I ENJOYED THE PROCESS. SO THEN I TOOK SCOTTSDALE 101, AND I WAS AMAZED AT HOW AMAZING OUR CITY IS. AND I'VE LIVED IN TEMPE, I'VE LIVED IN MESA, CHANDLER OVER THE 35 YEARS AND BEEN IN SCOTTSDALE FOR 10 YEARS. I'M A VERY PASSIONATE PERSON ABOUT JUSTICE AND FAIRNESS. I'VE TAKEN TWO 40-HOUR MEDIATION CLASSES, ONE THROUGH THE EEOC IN PHOENIX, AND I SELL REAL ESTATE. I'M A REAL ESTATE BROKER CURRENTLY WITH HOME SMART. AND I REALLY HAVE ALWAYS BELIEVED IN THE PROCESS OF EVERYBODY BEING HEARD, EVERYBODY GETTING SOMETHING OUT OF THE TRANSACTION IN A FAIR WAY. AND ONE OF THE THINGS THAT I REMEMBER ABOUT MY MEDIATION TRAINING WAS ONE OF THE TEACHERS KEPT SAYING, WHY DO YOU THINK GOD GAVE YOU TWO EARS AND ONLY ONE MOUTH? SO I FEEL I'VE BEEN ON PRIVATE BOARDS BEFORE, BUT NOTHING PUBLIC, AND I'M NOT AN IDEALOGUE, I'M SOMEBODY WITH A POSITION, I'M SOMEBODY WILLING TO LISTEN AND WORK TOGETHER AND SOLVE WHATEVER PROBLEMS ARE BEFORE US. BEFORE RETIRING, I HAD A 30-YEAR CAREER IN SOUTH FLORIDA AS A REALTOR-BROKER AND WORKED 25 OF THOSE YEARS IN NEW HOME SALES AND MANAGEMENT FOR SOME OF THE NATION'S LARGEST DEVELOPERS. DURING THE PAST TWO YEARS, I'VE HAD SEVERAL OCCASIONS TO WITNESS THE SCOTTSDALE CITY COURT SYSTEM. I'VE BEEN A RESIDENT OF SCOTTSDALE FOR 20 YEARS. THE REASON WHY I WANT TO SERVE ON THIS BOARD, I BELIEVE THESE BOARDS NEED TO BE STAFFED WITH PEOPLE THAT KNOW THE CITY, HAVE BEEN AROUND FOR A LONG TIME AND KNOW THE GROWING ISSUES OF WHAT IS FACING THE CITY. MY EXPERIENCES ARE NOT WELL WITHIN LINE OF WHAT THE COMMITTEE WANTS BUT I'M A LANDSCAPER IRRIGATION PERSON AND I'VE BEEN AROUND FOR SOME TIME TO KNOWING WHAT IS GOING ON AND ALL THAT. Laurie Coe: THANK YOU, COUNCIL FOR GIVING ME THIS OPPORTUNITY TO SPEAK AGAIN. --THIS OPPORTUNITY TO SPEAK AGAIN. I GUESS I WAS HEDGING MY BETS BY APPLYING FOR TWO COMMISSIONS. I WANT TO BRIEFLY TELL YOU I'M LAURIE COE, SCOTTSDALE, ARIZONA, 85260. WHEN I WAS VERY SMALL, MY PARENTS LIVED IN AN EXPERIMENT IN INTERNATIONAL LIVING WITH PEOPLE WHO WORKED AT THE U.N. AND ALL OF MY FRIENDS WERE FROM ALL OVER THE WORLD AND I HAD NO IDEA WHAT MY IDENTITY WAS. AND WHEN I WAS ABOUT 10, THEY MOVED TO A SUBURB ON LONG ISLAND AND IT WAS IN A TOWN THAT HAD NEVER SEEN A JEWISH PERSON, WHICH OUR FAMILY WAS. AND IT WAS LIKE I WAS A GREEN MONSTER, WHEN I SHOWED UP AS A 10-YEAR-OLD AND I WAS VERY ACUTELY MADE AWARE OF HOW THAT FEELS AND I WORKED REALLY HARD AT FITTING IN. I ACTUALLY WENT TO MY 50th HIGH SCHOOL REUNION THIS WEEKEND AND FORTUNATELY, OUR CLASS REALLY WAS COLOR BLIND BY THE TIME WE FINISHED HIGH SCHOOL, AND WE WERE A VERY DIVERSE GROUP OF KIDS AND WE ARE ALL WENT ON TO COLLEGE.
