  Councilmember Korte seconded the motion. No vote taken.
- Vice Mayor Smith made an alternate motion to adopt Ordinance No. 4242 and Resolution No. 10381 with the following modifications: (1) Any time the word "event" is used add the adjective "special" in front of it; (2) amend Section 22-7(a) to read, "An event shall not occur more than 10 consecutive days or 24 days during the calendar year, and, of the 24 calendar days per year, no more than 10 total days in any calendar quarter, unless otherwise provided by this Chapter"; and (3) amend Section 22-7(b) to read, "An art-related event shall not be approved by the event administrator in the area of Downtown Scottsdale, as defined in the Downtown Character Area Plan, if it conflicts with a scheduled Thursday night ArtWalk." Councilwoman Klapp seconded the motion, which carried 6/1, with Councilwoman Milhaven dissenting.
- Councilmember Korte made an amended motion to the alternate motion that Section 22-7(a) remain "An event shall not occur more than 10 consecutive or 24 total days during the period of January 1 through March 31, and no more than 30 consecutive days or 48 total days during the calendar year unless otherwise provided in this Chapter." The motion died for lack of a second.
