 Councilmember Korte seconded the motion, which carried 7/0.
- Councilmember Korte made a motion that, when Acting City Manager Brian Biesemeyer returns to his position as Water Resources Director, he be granted a pay increase of 3 percent of his salary for that position, effective for the pay period beginning June 12, 2016, and he be granted a one-time allotment of an additional two weeks' vacation. Vice Mayor Littlefield seconded the motion, which carried 7/0.
