CALL TO ORDER

Mayor David D. Ortega called to order a Regular Meeting of the Scottsdale City Council at 5:01 P.M. on Tuesday, March 29, 2022 in the City Hall Kiva Forum.

MAYOR'S REPORT

Mayor Ortega asked for a moment of silence to pray for the safety and peace for the Ukrainian people.

Mayor Ortega recognized the passing of two notable members of the Scottsdale community. Joseph Coatsworth was the Board Chairman for the Neighborhood Outreach for Access to Healthcare (NOAH) and previously served as the Chief Executive Officer of the Arizona Association of Community Health Centers. Darlene Petersen was a retired nurse who was a frequent visitor to City Hall to express her opinion and knew the beauty of Scottsdale. Ms. Petersen was a past president of the Scottsdale Historical Society and was responsible for many of the actions they supported to create historic buildings in Scottsdale.

Mayor Ortega noted that the McDowell Sonoran Preserve's Fraesfield and Granite Mountain trailheads were awarded with two environmental excellence Crescordia awards from Arizona Forward.

Assistant City Manager Bill Murphy gave the PowerPoint presentation (attached) on possible future uses related to the Fifth and Goldwater parking area.

There was Council consensus on the following item:

- Create open space for a park while retaining some parking.

Councilmembers made the following suggestions:

- Provide a deck park to retain some of the parking.
- Install a surface that is soft and absorbent and lends itself for other uses, such as a Farmer's Market or other events.
- Not compromise parking spaces for open space.
- Plant desert landscaping that is drought resistant and uses the least amount of water.
- Install drip systems and/or other devices that will funnel and recycle the water used for the landscaping.
- Install air pumps for bicycle use.
- Include rest areas.
- Install signage for directions to parking, bicycle and bicycle racks, and pedestrian paths to access businesses and services.
- Ensure sidewalks and walkways have a level, non-slip surface.
- Install art features, such as murals, a sculpture garden, or decorative ramadas.
- Determine if there is accessibility to accommodate food trucks in the area.
- Explore options to use one-time money from development proposals approved in the downtown area to fund expansion of a park.
- Add 30 feet to the Canal area to project a deck over the canal that would provide covered parking, resulting in a usable, inviting canal side deck park.

PUBLIC COMMENT

- Alex McLaren spoke in support of the 2nd Street Improvements project stating it was an exciting project with opportunities to make the streetscape special.
- Bob Pejman expressed concern about parking in the 2nd Street Improvements project, including the loss of parking specified in the Museum Square development agreement.
- French Thompson asked that there be no loss of parking associated with the 2nd Street Improvements project.

2. 2nd Street Improvements

Dig Studios Associate Principal Brandon Sobiech gave the PowerPoint presentation (attached) on the 2nd Street Improvements project.

Councilmembers made the following suggestions:

- Extend shading elements to expand corners and connectivity to Scottsdale Road and Main Street allowing for access to businesses.
- Expand the eight-foot bike path or covered walkways into a continuous loop from 2nd Street to Scottsdale Road to Main Street and returning to the Civic Center Plaza.
- Encourage parties to work together to expand treescapes from Civic Center Plaza onto 2nd Street.

- Encourage the bulk of vehicular traffic to use the split at the couplet located at Scottsdale Road and Civic Center Drive to remain on Scottsdale Road to alleviate traffic congestion at 2nd Street.
- Narrow the width of the bicycle lanes or have bicycles flow onto the road along 2nd Street to retain parking spaces.
- Provide information and a map to the City Council related to the location of existing and proposed parking spaces.
- Retain the texture, feel, and look of Old Town Scottsdale in the plans.
- Do not eliminate parking spaces as agreed to in the Museum of the West contract.
- Upgrade the street pavement.
- Install large, easy-to-read signage and lighting in the area.
- Install improved wayfinding signage to make it more eye catching and directional.
- Implement improvements discussed in the presentation to make 2nd Street a destination area that will attract more visitors.
- Beautify the area around the Scottsdale Museum of Contemporary Art to make it more user-friendly and engaging.
- Increase awareness related to available parking and amenities on 2nd Street.
- Develop strategic areas with more parking spots and eliminate small parking lots and develop them into parks or retail space.
- Focus on the use of space that is judicious and beneficial.
- Locate ride share drop-off sites at convenient locations on every block or every other block to eliminate congestion.
- Conduct public outreach related to this proposal.

Petition Purpose: We, the undersigned residents of the City of Scottsdale and neighbors who use North 68th Street, request that the City of Scottsdale build sidewalks on North 68th Street to connect with the sidewalks on East Camelback Road and on East Indian School Road. Additionally, we oppose the abandonment case 2-AB-2022 at 6750 East Exeter Boulevard that would surrender an essential right-of-way needed to complete the sidewalk path on North 68th Street. Building a sidewalk along N 68th St will improve the safety and quality of life for pedestrians, cyclists, and vehicles along this transportation corridor.

**Unfinished Business:
Complete the Sidewalk along N 68th St**

Dear Mayor and City Councilpersons,

The City of Scottsdale in 2019 rebuilt the bridge over the canal at 68th Street and Indian School to repair damage and also to improve the traffic flow for all who pass through that area. This rebuilt intersection smoothly and efficiently accommodates vehicles and safely connects pedestrians and bicyclists to the canal path and sidewalks. However, there is no sidewalk along 68th Street travelling north of the bridge and pedestrians are forced to walk on 68th Street between the 68th St canal-bridge and Camelback Rd.

In recent years there has been increased traffic pressure on our city roads with the building of high-density apartment buildings and other development in South Scottsdale. For example, in 2019 the construction of Optima Sonora Village, on the corner of 68th St and Camelback Rd, was completed bringing 768 residential units and a similar number of vehicles. These residents, neighbors, visitors, and workers have wanted to connect with the amenities of the canal-walking path, Old Town, Fashion Square and The Valley Ho. In addition, citizens who use the public bus system should be able to walk safely between the canal-bridge and Camelback Rd. Yet there is no way for a pedestrian to safely walk along 0.3 miles of 68th St between Camelback and Indian School Rds; the sidewalk on 68th Street needs to be completed.

In the midst of this background, Scottsdale City staff has advanced an application (case 2-AB-2022) to the Planning Commission, a request by a resident at 6750 East Exeter Blvd for the city to abandon a portion of its right-of-way along 68th Street where a sidewalk could be built. The Planning Commission will hear this abandonment case on April 13, 2022.

Our concern is that there is no plan or funding allocated for the development of sidewalks along 68th Street between Camelback Rd and Indian School Rd. To consider granting this abandonment request before the development of a sidewalk plan potentially forecloses future sidewalk development and risks increasing the cost of a sidewalk.

We respectfully request that the City Council along with the Planning Commission immediately put on hold any consideration of this application (2-AB-2022) and direct staff to complete a plan with funding for the construction of a sidewalk along 68th Street.

The dynamic situation along this stretch of road suggests that motor vehicle, bicycle and pedestrian traffic will increase. It is crucial that the City Council considers as a matter of some urgency this citizen petition, with over 200 interested citizens' signatures, and provides the leadership to mitigate the current and growing pressure on North 68th Street.

Good Afternoon Mayor Ortega and Councilmembers,

The Reason for this Petition

The City of Scottsdale is not currently aligned with state law requiring that any person desiring to use the title Architect or practice Architecture must first become a licensed Architect.

Architects are statutorily charged with protecting the health, safety and welfare of the public. The title Architect and practice of Architecture is protected in all 50 states.

Per the Arizona Revised Statutes, the pathway to becoming an Architect is one of Education, Internship and Examination. The Architect Registration Examination is the minimum benchmark standard for practicing Architecture.

It is illegal for any unlicensed person (a "Non-Registrant") to use the title Architect or practice Architecture; specifically when a Structural Engineer (a "Registrant") is required on the project. Reason being: it is illegal for a Structural Engineer to "rubber stamp" Architectural drawings for that unlicensed person. To do so is called "Aiding & Abetting"; which is a very serious offense in Arizona (as it should be). There are also the "Preparatory Offenses": Attempt, Solicitation, Conspiracy and Facilitation when the Non-Registrant seeks out a Registrant to assist them in breaking the law.

Doctors, Attorneys, Realtors, Contractors...and Architects: these are all licensed professions and, in all cases, licensing existing for one reason: to protect the health, safety and welfare of the public.

You cannot have two mirror-image professions, one with a license and one without, providing the exact same services to the public.

Can a property owner design their own primary residence? Yes...with the assistance of a licensed Architect (according to Arizona law) but it does not give them the right to call themselves an Architect or offer Architectural services to others. This is not unlike the same property owner having the right to build their own home as the "Owner-Builder".

Any person who commits the following is guilty of a Class 2 Misdemeanor:
Practices, offers to practice or by any implication holds themselves out as qualified to practice Architecture if the person is not a licensed Architect. Defendants who have a previous conviction for the same offense in the last 2 years will be sentenced as if they had been convicted for the next level of criminal offense: a **Class 1** misdemeanor.

The Goal of this Petition

To enact a new City of Scottsdale ordinance requiring all building permit drawings to be prepared, signed and sealed by a licensed Arizona Architect; bringing the City into compliance with Arizona state law (as described above).

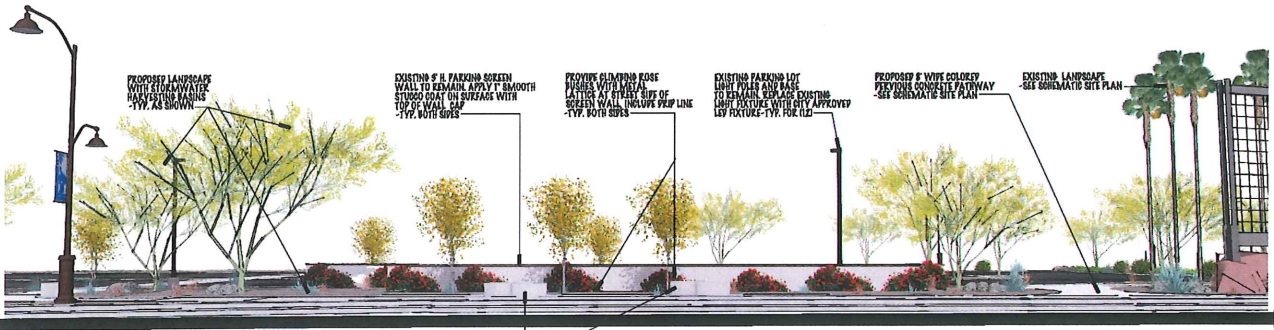

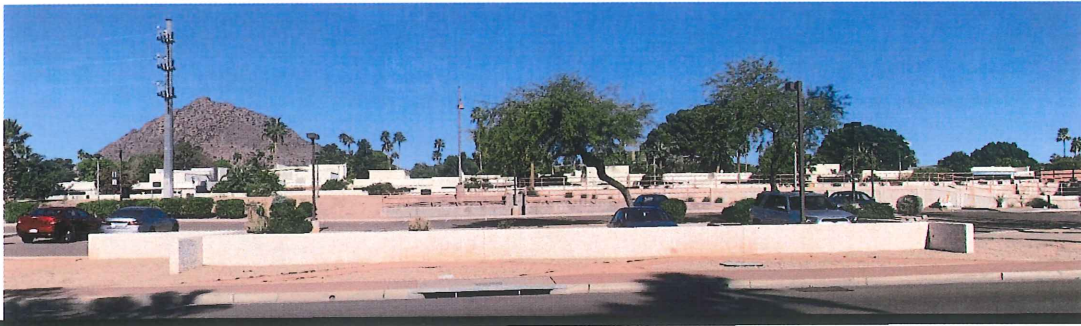

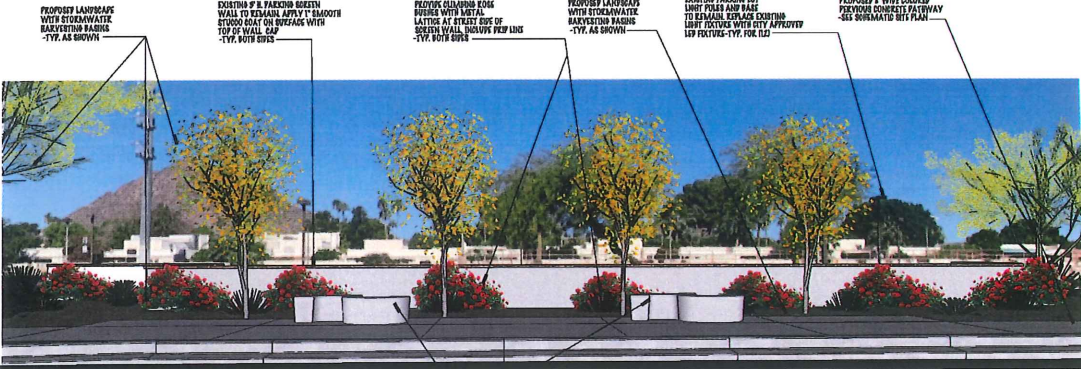

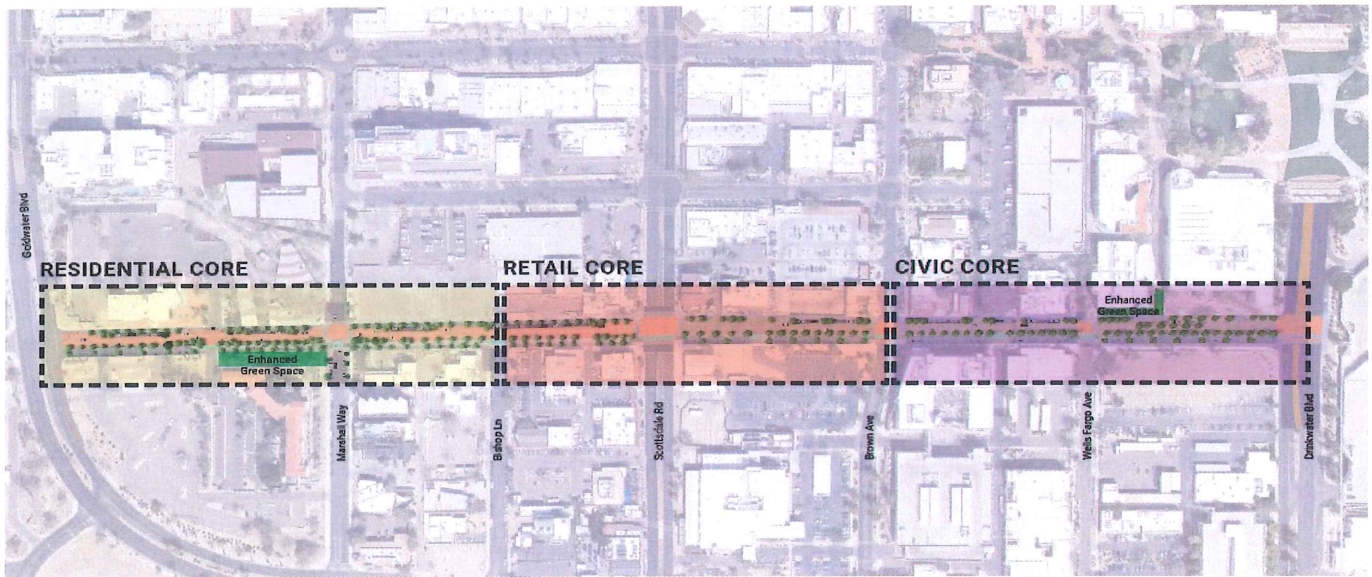

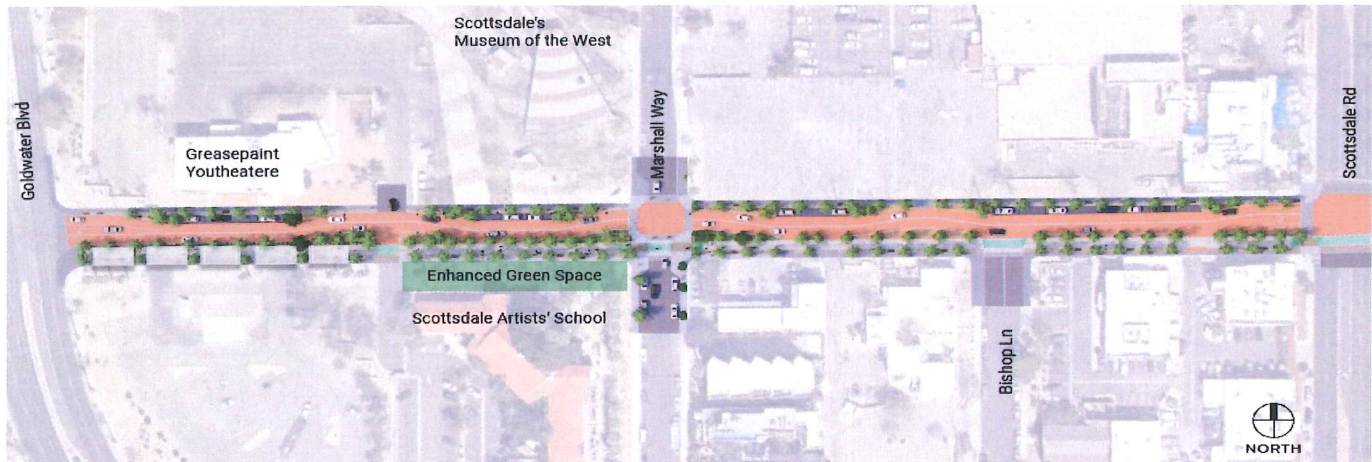

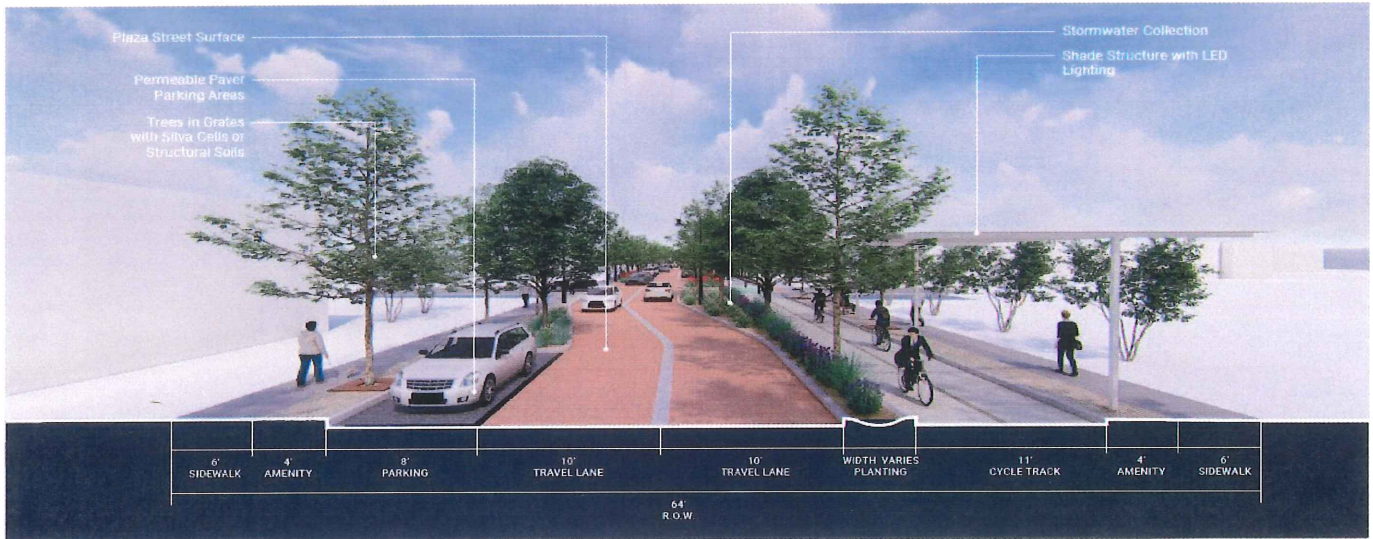

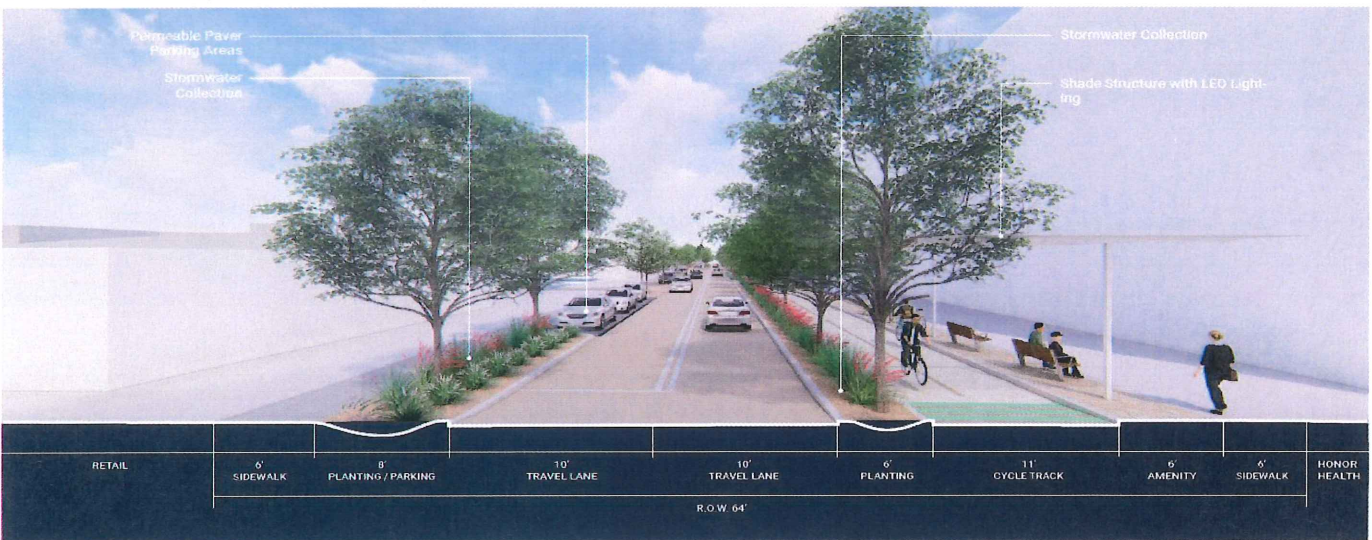
