Comparisons by Demographic Subgroups

2016



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Summary

The National Citizen Survey[™] (The NCS[™]) is a collaborative effort between National Research Center, Inc. (NRC) and the International City/County Management Association (ICMA). The survey and its administration are standardized to assure high quality research methods and directly comparable results across The NCS communities. This report discusses differences in opinion of survey respondents by age, gender, housing unit type (attached or detached), housing tenure (rent or own) and race/ethnicity.

Responses in the following tables show only the proportion of respondents giving a certain answer; for example, the percent of respondents who rated the quality of life as "excellent" or "good," or the percent of respondents who attended a public meeting more than once a month. ANOVA and chi-square tests of significance were applied to these comparisons of survey questions. A "p-value" of 0.05 or less indicates that there is less than a 5% probability that differences observed between subgroups are due to chance; or in other words, a greater than 95% probability that the differences observed are "real." Where differences were statistically significant, they have been shaded grey.

The margin of error for this report is generally no greater than plus or minus six percentage points around any given percent reported for the entire sample (283 completed surveys). For subgroups of responses, the margin of error increases because the sample size for the subgroup is smaller. For subgroups of approximately 100 respondents, the margin of error is plus or minus 10 percentage points.

Notable differences between demographic subgroups included the following:

- Residents who owned their homes tended to give higher ratings to general aspects of Community Characteristics than those who rented their homes, including to the overall quality of life in Scottsdale, the city as a place to live, their neighborhood as a place to live, Scottsdale as a place to retire and the overall appearance of the city. Respondents aged 18-34 were more likely to give positive ratings to aspects of Recreation and Wellness, while residents who were 35 or older, male or living in detached housing were more likely to favorably rate aspects of Community Engagement.
- In Governance, where differences in opinion were observed, survey respondents aged 18-34 tended to give higher ratings to general aspects of Governance and to aspects of Mobility than their older counterparts, although residents 35 or older were more likely to positively rate the services provided by the State Government. Homeowners were more likely to positively rate aspects of Natural Environment than renters, and those living in detached housing tended to give higher ratings to Built Environment than those living in attached housing.
- Within the pillar of Participation, respondents who owned their homes or who lived in detached housing were more likely to indicate that they planned to remain in Scottsdale for the next five years and would recommend living in Scottsdale to someone who asked than those who rented or lived in attached housing. Respondents who owned their homes or who were white and not Hispanic were less likely to have reported a crime or to have been the victim of a crime than their counterparts, although renters were more likely than homeowners to have stocked supplies for an emergency. Residents living in detached housing were also more likely than other residents to have participated in aspects of Economy and Education and Enrichment. Where differences were observed, residents 35 or older tended to participate more frequently in aspects of Community Engagement than their counterparts, although younger residents 18-34 were more likely to have campaigned for an issue, cause or candidate than older residents.
- Residents aged 35-54 tended to be more likely to have ridden a mountain bike or to have rock climbed in the Scottsdale McDowell Sonoran Preserve than their younger or older counterparts, and residents under the age of 55 were more likely to have visited a Preserve trailhead or to have taken out of town visitors to do activities in the Preserve than older respondents.
- When asked about sources of information about the City, survey respondents 35 and older were more likely to rate their utility bill, the Parks and Recreation brochure, the City website, email subscription or newsletter and NextDoor as major or minor sources of information than younger residents. Respondents under the age of 35 were more likely to utilize Facebook as a major or minor source of City information than their older counterparts.
