About this Report

As part of its participation in The National Citizen Survey[™], the City of Scottsdale conducted a mailed survey of 1,500 residents. Surveys were mailed to randomly selected households in November 2016 and data were collected through January 9, 2017. After the official data collection period was over and the data were reported (see the report, *The National Citizen Survey: Community Livability Report, Scottsdale, AZ, 2016*), the City made available a web-based survey to its residents through a link on the City's website. Visitors to the site were able to complete the survey during January 2017 and 292 surveys were received.

This report contains the results of this administration of the web-based survey and have not been weighted to current population estimates of Scottsdale.
