

Pastel
1. PASTELS: * Minimum: Beginners box of pastels [NOT oil pastels!]-* for 1st class * soft pastels-ie: Rembrant, Grumbacher, etc
2 *PAPER: To begin, <u>for 1st class</u> , buy 2 sheets of <u>'CANSON' paper</u> - [to be torn into quarters for practice] - preferably <u>NOT white</u> , <u>or</u> a tablet of <u>STRATHMORE CHARCOAL paper</u> in <u>assorted tints</u> - #561-2 * The paper you use must have <u>'tooth'</u> in order to hold the pastel pigment!*
3. Other materials: [ASAP] To Mount your paper on-Your Choice: A piece of masonite, a painting board from an art store, heavy cardboard or Foam Core board A roll of masking tape- 3/4" is fine, or clips to hold paper on board A few pieces of VINE charcoal A kneeded eraser Rubber gloves - tight fitting, latex Apron or old shirt - this medium can be messy! A small_old, hard- bristle paint brush to scrape off pastels And a good attitude! ready to have some fun!! Materials can be purchased at any Art Store. ***********************************
