GENERAL PARK IMPROVEMENTS



Remodeled restrooms on the West Corridor. New restrooms located within family amenity area that includes family changing rooms



Wi-Fi accessible throughout entire Civic Center.



LED, programmable exterior Civic Center lighting



Accessibility Improvements:

- Lowering of grade along the west entry corridor allowing for universal access and enhanced visual connections from Main Street.
- New accessible pedestrian connection from Civic Center to 2nd Street to the south.
- Re-grading of East Bowl to soften steep slopes and provide greater access.

Festival

Expanded event tent layout space with room for 230 10'x10' tents throughout Civic Center in non-turf areas.



Daily Performance

- **Busker platforms** throughout the park to encourage daily performances.
- New **permanent stage** at East Bowl for large music performances and theater.
- New Multi-functional **Community Plaza** to host outdoor fitness classes, dance and arts, movie nights, workshops and other community activities.



Daily Program:

- New **Children's Garden** area adjacent to library with reading room, butterfly gardens and sculptural play elements
- **The Grove** picnic area with game tables and folly seating.
- New interactive **water and fog plaza**.
- Enhanced **Marshall Garden** with small wedding lawn along with picturesque **botanical garden** to enhance photography activities and educational tours
- **History Museum Courtyard** with monument steps offering a platform for civic discourse and educational lectures.
- **School Yard** green space offering flexible area for small performance and additional spill-out space for markets.

Playable Art

SUSTAINABILITY - WATER USE

5,875,000 GALLONS




Water Use Reduction

Reduction in **turf lawn** and replacement with low-water use, drip irrigated plant materials, will result in a net savings of almost **4 million gallons** per year in water savings. Furthermore, the elimination of the **west entry water feature, the east bowl water feature and the reduction in the lagoon footprint** will save an additional **1,875,000 gallons** per year in water use. It all adds up to **5.875 million gallons of water savings per year, the equivalent of approximate use 125 homes in one year.**



Rain Water Collection



Use of **permeable pavements** throughout the site with underground conveyance.



Introduction of **planted bioswales** throughout the site to collect and capture stormwater.



Targeted **roof water** collection at the East Bowl structure that supplies the existing trees with an extra boost of water.
