042 PRE SITE – required on all building sites prior to starting any site work or construction.

001 POOL ROUGH (PRE-GUNITE) – Check setback of the pool per city approved site plan. Check placement of steel per city approved plans and details.

010 ELECTRIC UNDERGROUND - Check underground electric for depth, size & type. Check circuit conductors. Check grounding and bonding of any metal within 5 ft of waters edge. Check to see that all glass within 5 ft of waters edge is safety glass.

031 FINAL SITE – Check city sidewalks for damage during pool construction. Check native plants and for proper site drainage.

002 POOL FINAL (PRE-PLASTER) – Check all fencing and gates. Check barrier between house and pool for proper alarms, doors, etc. Check final electric connections at pool equipment and electric panel. Check vacuum breaker. Check material clean-up.

Please note: Gas for pool heater requires a separate permit.

ORDINANCE 3505, SECTION 116.1
CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY, WORKING HOURS

ALL BUILDING CONSTRUCTION AND ASSOCIATED WORK ON PRIVATE PROPERTY
SHALL NOT COMMENCE PRIOR TO 1/2 HOUR BEFORE OFFICIAL SUNRISE
NOR CONTINUE AFTER OFFICIAL SUNSET.

IMPORTANT NOTICE

City of Scottsdale Inspection Services will be inspecting the condition of the alley during all phases of your construction project.

It is your responsibility to contain construction debris away from the alley, and to arrange for its proper disposal. City crews will not collect cement, dirt or any other construction debris; it is illegal to place cement, dirt or any other construction debris in the alleys or in any City refuse container.

Failure to maintain the current condition of the alley will result in the issuance of a Stop Work Order and/or a citation for illegal dumping.

AVISO IMPORTANTE

El departamento de los servicios de la inspección de la Ciudad de Scottsdale examinará de la condición del callejón durante todas las fases de su proyecto de construcción.

Es su responsabilidad contener la ruina de la construcción alejado del callejón, y para arreglar para la disposición apropiada de ella. Los equipos de la Ciudad no recogerán el cemento, la basura o ninguna otra ruina de la construcción; es ilegal colocar el cemento, la basura o ninguna otra ruina de la construcción en los callejones o en cualquier envase de la basura de la Ciudad.

Falta de mantener limpia la condición del callejón dará lugar a la emisión de una "Orden de Para de Trabajo" y/o a una citación de descargo ilegal.
