



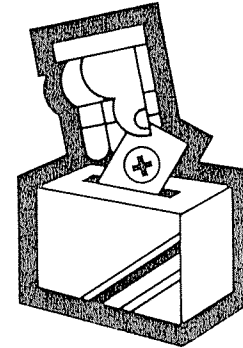

3. Any qualified voter who at 7:00 p.m. is in the line of waiting voters shall be allowed to cast a ballot.

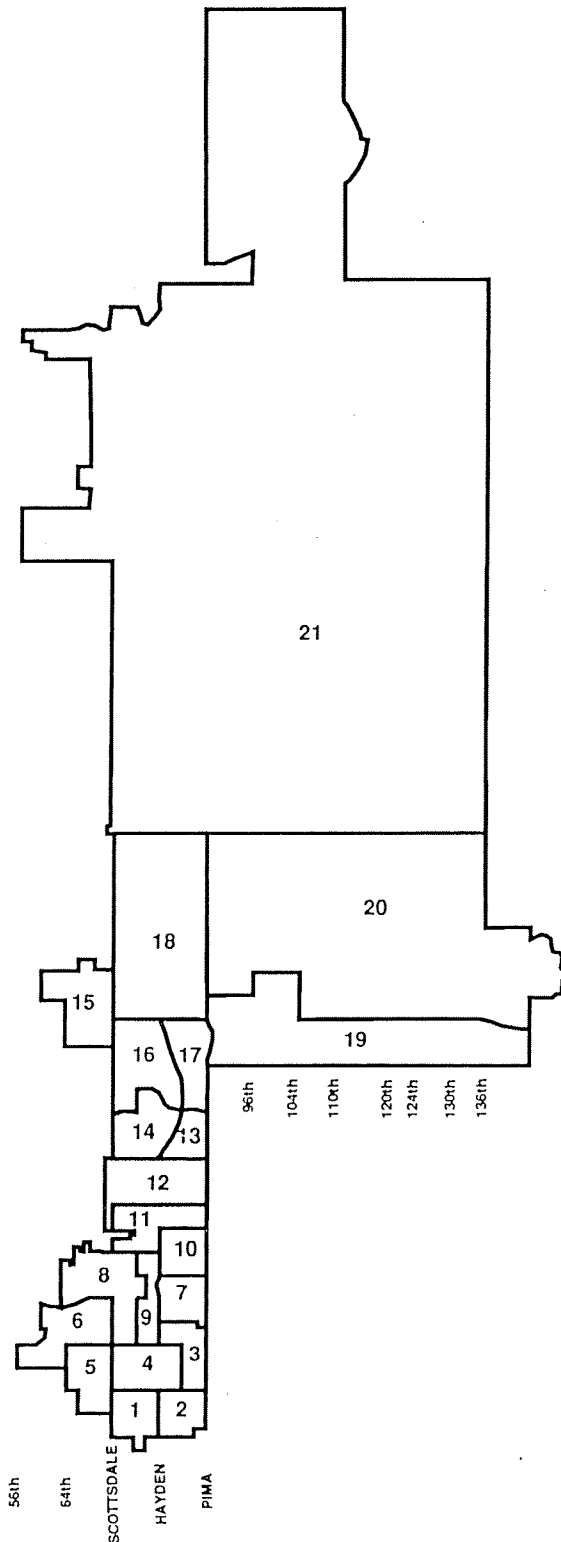

On Tuesday, November 7, Scottsdale citizens will be asked to approve \$293.1 million in bonds to fund the city's five-year Capital Improvements Plan adopted by the City Council in June.

The five-year CIP totals \$415 million, with 70 percent of its funding dependent on voter-approved bonds. Major components of the program are transportation (33 percent), water (20 percent), wastewater (16 percent) and community facilities (13 percent).

THE BALLOT

The bond ballot will include the following propositions:

1.

TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENTS \$99,338,900

Make major and minor street improvements (such as widening and center turn lanes), relieve traffic bottlenecks, expand the computerized signal system, and construct traffic signals. Specific projects include completing the East and West Couplets; widening Shea Boulevard to six lanes from 124th to 144th Street; widening Scottsdale Road to six lanes from McDowell to Earl; and completing the last segment of Hayden Road, from Via De Ventura to Shea Boulevard, to six lanes.

2.

PIMA ROAD IMPROVEMENTS & BUFFERING/ MCDOWELL ROAD TO VIA LINDA \$5,973,500

Improve portions of Pima Road between McDowell and Via Linda, enclose the drainage channel on the western side of the roadway and provide buffering along the existing frontage road.

3.

POLICE, FIRE AND COURT FACILITIES \$7,940,000

Remodel the City Court/Police building to provide a third courtroom and other necessary space; construct a joint police/fire training facility; construct one permanent fire station, four temporary fire stations, and relocate an existing station to the Airport; purchase an automated fingerprint identification system and new police trunked voice radio communications system.

4.

STORM SEWER AND FLOOD PROTECTION \$46,723,000

Construct or improve detention basins, culvert and channel projects and other storm drainage projects to provide flood protection to homes and structures, and provide safe roadways as consistent with federal rules, state statutes and case law. Although we have not experienced a citywide flood since the 1970s, localized flooding of homes and businesses and road closures do occur.

5.

PARKS, RECREATIONAL FACILITIES AND PUBLIC LIBRARIES \$27,637,200

Construct five new community parks. Upgrade facilities or equipment at the following parks: Eldorado, Vista Del Camino, Scottsdale Ranch, Northsight, Cactus, Chesnutt, and Indian School. Improve ballfields at Yavapai and Chaparral Parks, Pima, Laguna, Cocopah and Mohave Schools. Construct Scottsdale's second branch library, Palomino -- a joint venture with the Scottsdale Unified School District at the 124th Street and Shea high school location. Expand Scottsdale's Civic Center Library, purchase compact shelving and storage for Mustang Library and upgrade the automated book cataloging system at both facilities.

6.

MULTIUSE SPORTS AND CULTURAL FACILITIES \$8,425,000

Construct a replacement facility for the current Scottsdale Stadium which was built in 1956. The new facility will be a multiuse complex for sports and cultural activities with approximately 7,000 seats and will include grandstands, lights, locker/shower rooms, offices, training rooms, a press room, restrooms and concession areas. Funds will also be used to construct and improve training areas, offices, and observation areas at Indian School Park.

7.

INDIAN BEND WASH BIKE AND PEDESTRIAN PATH \$2,422,800

Complete the remaining link in the Indian Bend Wash bike and pedestrian path system between Camelback Road and McCormick Parkway. This will provide a continuous path (not in conflict with traffic) for bicycling, walking, skating, etc., from the Scottsdale/Tempe border to north of Shea Boulevard. The cost includes design, right-of-way acquisition and five underpasses.

8.

STREET LIGHTING \$2,067,000

Purchase the existing Arizona Public Service and Salt River Project city-billed streetlights on major arterials. A 27 percent savings on annual operational and maintenance costs is anticipated. This proposition also provides for speciality streetlighting in the historic downtown area of the city.

9.

DOWNTOWN STREETSCAPE
\$1,760,600

Improve streetscape and beautification of downtown's speciality areas with the installation of new paving, landscaping, signage, and seating areas in a public/private partnership of cost sharing with downtown property owners. All improvements will be in the public rights-of-way. The property owners of the Old Scottsdale, West Main, Marshall Way and Fifth Avenue areas will pay their share (50 percent) through an improvement district.

10.

**WATER AND WASTEWATER
TREATMENT PLANTS**
\$47,642,000

Design and construct the first phases of a regional wastewater reclamation plant and an advanced water- treatment plant in north-central Scottsdale in the vicinity of Bell and Pima Roads. The initial phase of each plant will have a capacity of 4.5 million gallons per day. The effluent from the wastewater treatment plant will be used primarily for irrigation of golf courses and parks. What is not used will be converted to potable water in the advanced water- treatment plant and then recharged to the underground aquifer.

11.

WATER AND WASTEWATER FACILITIES
\$43,198,000

Make improvements to the water and sewer systems of the City. Specific projects include designing and building initial recharge and recovery facilities to store water from various sources; a distribution system for reclaimed water so it can be used for irrigation; a new filtration plant in south Scottsdale to aid in cleaning up TCE groundwater contamination; design and construction of lead-removal facilities at six well sites; and pipelines and reservoirs to accommodate need and expected growth.

12.

**AUTHORIZATION FOR A TWO-TENTHS OF
ONE PERCENT INCREASE IN TRANSACTION
PRIVILEGE TAX**

For the purpose of funding transportation improvements, this ballot proposition seeks voter approval for the City Council to take future action to approve a two-tenths of one percent increase in the transaction privilege tax (sales tax) dedicated to transportation. This would bring our sales tax rate to 6.7 percent (from 6.5 percent) -- the same as Phoenix.

THE BONDS

If authorized, the bonds will be sold in increments over the next five-year period. They will be issued as either General Obligation (G.O.) Bonds or, in the case of water and wastewater projects, Revenue Bonds.

To fund the General Obligation Bonds, the city's property tax rate would increase from \$.73 per \$100 assessed valuation in fiscal year 1989-90, to a high of \$1.11 in fiscal year 1992-93. Revenue Bonds will be repaid from water and wastewater fees, which are projected to rise over the next four years to fund the water and wastewater program.

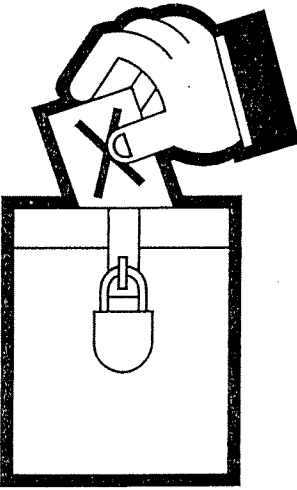
