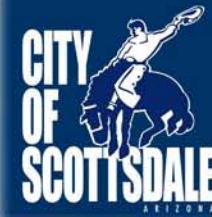


Study Area and Background

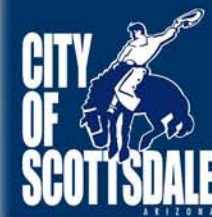
- The 70th Street alignment between Wilshire Dr. and Thomas Rd.
 - 70th St does not exist here
 - Unpaved alley
 - Irrigation ditch
- No sidewalks
- Issues for northbound cyclists

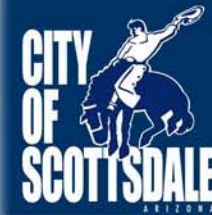

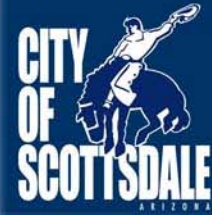

Looking west across 71st Street at the Thomas/70th St. intersection.

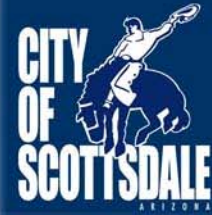
70th Street Pedestrian & Bicycle Connection

 - A Dye Design is our consultant

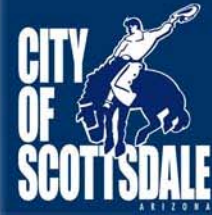

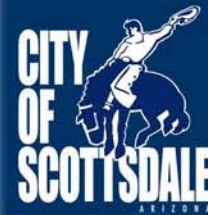
