

## Census 2010 Analysis

The national economic recession and foreclosure crisis had an adverse effect on the City causing a large number of foreclosures and vacant housing units. Staff anticipates that this is one of the primary causes of the City's lower than expected population figure.

The City of Scottsdale also has a large number of vacation homes. Vacation home owners are counted in their home state for the Census, therefore for Census purposes the home is considered vacant and the homeowners are not counted in Scottsdale's population figure.
