**Who can register:** Scottsdale residents with youth attending Elementary School, Grades 1-5 at Horizon Park, Grades 1-6 at all other locations. (Must be at least 6 yrs old by 9/1/12 and in the first grade)

**Cost\*:** \$544.00 for the year or 10 monthly installments of \$55.00. Fee includes the program opening early for SUSD early release days. \*Fees subject to change.

**Dates:** All programs begin on August 8, 2012 and conclude on May 24, 2013. The youth programs will be closed on school holidays, during Fall Recess, Winter Break, and Spring Break. All after-school programs will be open corresponding with "early release" days of the Scottsdale Unified School District.

**Times:** School release until 6pm, Monday – Friday.

**Registration:** Please use touch-tone or rec-link with the registration form on page 3, and follow registration guidelines. Registration for after school programs will be accepted on a first come, first served basis. Demand for these programs is high and space is limited. Also, a birth certificate original needs to be seen by city staff to complete your child's registration (for 1st grade participants only).
