



MIGHTY MUD MANIA '12 PERMISSION SLIP

Saturday, June 9th, 2012 from 8:00am to 2 pm, **Mighty Mud Mania** will be held at Chaparral Park, 5401 N. Hayden Road. This free event, is primarily for children aged 1 to 17 years. Children are encouraged to bring a non-perishable food item for donation to the Vista Food bank (or eyeglasses for donation to Lions Club.) The event includes "*The Original Mud Obstacle Course*," a footrace for 7 to 17 year olds **WHICH WILL BE conducted from 8am to 12noon**; with obstacles and mud pits as deep as 5 feet, to run, jump and crawl through; a ramp to climb up and over, ropes to swing on into mud, hay bales to climb, and a slide to go down, and a tube dive that children dive through, into a pit of mud. **Participants could be completely immersed in mud.** The "*Mini Mud Course*" is for children 6 years old and younger & there is also a "Mudville Town" for tiny tots. Mud pits, sand castle building, & water play areas, are also featured for 6 and under, 7 and older. Children will get muddy and wet in most activities. Park conditions will also be wet and slippery, which can result in falls and physical injury. Children need a permission slip to participate in the event and activities.

Children compete in "*The Original Mud Obstacle Course*" in two recommended age groups; 7-12 years and 13-17 years. **7-17 year olds can run this course from 8:00 am - 12:00 p.m.** (ADULTS will be able to run from 12:00pm to 2:00pm for \$10! See website for details!) The Children will alternate running through the course with the first races beginning at 8:00am. Children can line up **ANY** time during that period to run the *Original Mud Obstacle Course*. **Shoes and shirts must be worn to participate in all Mighty Mud Mania activities.** We suggest your child wear old, grubby clothing and old lace up shoes to compete in Mighty Mud Mania since there will be mud pits involved in the races. Please provide lunch money to your child. Food, soda and snacks will be sold during the event by several vendors. Many children attend this event, so please be patient as you may have to wait in line for the mud courses. ***Your child needs your permission to participate in Mighty Mud Mania activities.*** Please bring the signed permission slip, with you/your child to MIGHTY MUD MANIA.
