DURING THE MEETING, THE ADR WILL MARK ALL OF THE REQUIRED ITEMS FOR THE PERMIT THAT IS BEING REQUESTED. AFTER THE INITIAL MEETING TAKES PLACE, IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE APPLICANT TO SUBMIT ALL OF THE REQUIRED ITEMS. APPLICATIONS THAT ARE INCOMPLETE OR MISSING ITEMS CANNOT BE PROCESSED.

<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>1. Scottsdale Airport Aeronautical Business Permit Form-</b> The form must be completed in its entirety and signed/dated by the applicant or authorized representative.
<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>2. Articles of Organization-</b> for the applicant applying for the permit. Applicants must provide <u>one</u> of the following: 1). If the applicant is a corporation, a copy of the articles of incorporation as filed with the Corporate Commission; 2). If the applicant is a limited liability company, a copy of the articles of organization filed with the Corporation Commission; 3). If the applicant is a limited partnership, a copy of the certificate of limited partnership filed with the Secretary of State; 4). If the applicant is a general partnership, a copy of the written partnership agreement.

Documentation Regarding Authorized Representative-</b> If the applicant/authorized representative is not listed on the Articles of Organization, then the applicant must secure a letter from one of the company's officers who is listed on the Articles of Organization. This letter must indicate that the authorized representative is authorized to act on behalf of the company and it must be written on company letterhead. This letter must also contain current contact information for the person who is granting the authority to the representative.
<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>4. Description of the Scope of Service-</b> Provide a detailed explanation of the intended scope of operations and the types of services to be offered.

City of Scottsdale Business/Privilege Tax License-</b> The applicant must provide a copy of their Scottsdale Business/Privilege Tax License if the applicant maintains an office in the City and, advertises its location or customers are able to visit the location. An application and proof of fee payment is also acceptable.

### PART 3 - ADVISORY ITEMS

- **Fees-**Applicants shall be advised of the following key item(s) that will be necessary to comply with once the permit is approved. The following list includes but is not limited to:
  - **Fee payment-**Aircraft Management services will receive an Aeronautical Business Permit monthly payment form from the Aviation Administration office. The monthly fee for aircraft management on the Scottsdale Airport is:
    - \$100 for the management of one or more piston-engine aircraft less than 12,500 pounds certificated maximum takeoff weight; and
    - \$150 for the management of each turbine/jet aircraft less than 12,500 pounds certificated

- o maximum takeoff weight; and
  - o \$250 for the management of each aircraft weighing 12,500-29,999 pounds certificated maximum takeoff weight; and
  - o \$350 for the management of each aircraft weighing 30,000 pounds or more certificated maximum takeoff weight.
  - o If the Aircraft Management Services Operator is paying a permit fee for an aircraft under Aircraft Charter Services, the operator is not required to remit a fee under Aircraft Management Services Operator for the same aircraft
- Monthly fees are due and payable by the 20<sup>th</sup> day of the month following the month in which services were provided.
- Late fees will be assessed for payments received after the 1<sup>st</sup> day of the month.
