#### **Minutes**

1. Approval of the May 24, 2023 Regular Meeting Minutes.

Vice Chair Young moved to approve the May 24, 2023 regular meeting minutes. Seconded by Commissioner Kaminski, the motion carried unanimously with a vote of seven (7) to zero (0).

### 2. 1-TA-2022 (Care Homes Text Amendment)

This case was continued by the Planning Commission on April 26, 2023. Request by the City of Scottsdale to amend the Zoning Ordinance (Ord. No. 455), Article I, Section 1.806 (Disability Accommodation), Article I, Section 1.920 (Request for Disability Accommodation), Article III, Section 3.100 (Definitions), Article V, Section 5.012 (Single-family Residential, R1-190— Use Regulations), and Article V, Section 5.102 (Single-family Residential, R1-43 - Use Regulations) to clarify what constitutes a care home and modify the process and criteria for a Disability Accommodation. Item No. 2; Vice Chair Young moved to make a recommendation to City Council for approval of Case 1-TA-2022 after determining that the proposed Text Amendment is consistent and conforms with the adopted General Plan.
