1. **REVIEW OF TONIGHT'S REGULAR MEETING AGENDA**

- **Approval of Meeting Minutes**

No edits were suggested to the minutes of the Study Session and Regular meeting of April 16, 2015, and the May 7, 2015 Special Meeting minutes.

- **Scottsdale Bond Program**

Mr. Worth will present an update on the Scottsdale Bond Program and will provide detail on specific projects and the Council process. Mr. Basha indicated that this item will go before the City Council on June 2 to accept election in November 2015. If this bond election is successful, the Council might consider having a larger bond election in fall 2016 or early 2017.

- **U.S. Bicycle Route System**

This same presentation went before the Paths & Trails Subcommittee at which a recommendation was made to the Transportation Commission that they consider recommending to City Council that a portion of the U.S. Bicycle Route 90 pass through Scottsdale.

- **City of Phoenix Bike Share Program Update**

Mr. Basha indicated that this program has received positive press. Ms. Conklu will present the pros and cons of the program. Mr. Basha noted that at this time, the City has the opportunity to learn lessons from other cities before Scottsdale jumps on board with the Bike Share program.

- **Road Safety Audit – Frank Lloyd Wright/Greenway-Hayden Loop**

Mr. Williams has done an analysis of the Frank Lloyd Wright/Greenway-Hayden Loop intersection, which is one of the largest intersections in the City. It was noted that there are staff recommendations for solid improvements that still need to be done.

- **Communication Tools**

Ms. Walter will review two social media communication tools used in the City. These tools are “myScottsdale” app and “nextdoor.”

- **Other Transportation Projects and Programs Status**

Mr. Basha will provide an update on a few projects.
