- Northsight Extension Project

Mr. George Williams will present an update on the Northsight Extension Project focusing on the Northsight/Hayden roundabout. Mr. Williams will also review traffic volumes and crash and travel time data along and around the Northsight Extension area.

- Other Transportation Projects and Programs Status

Ms. Clemann will provide a couple project updates, which will include a second update on the Cab Connection Program. Ms. Clemann mentioned that since Discount Cab has terminated providing taxi service to Cab Connection participants as of July 8, the transition in change of service has been seamless.

Commissioner Bretz encouraged staff to keep exploring the potential use of smart cards instead of taxi vouchers for this service.
