WestWorld	Yes	Yes	Dates are held approximately ten days; longer if no one else is requesting the same date. No deposit required until an agreement is drafted.	Damage/cleanup deposits are not required. Clean-up is charged on the final invoice at \$25/man/hour plus equipment (backhoe, forklift, etc.) when applicable.
Scottsdale Stadium	Yes	Yes -1/15- 4/1 is reserved exclusively for the Giants. Outside of that it's first come first served.	Facility can have a tentative hold for no fee. For a definite hold or if there are competing events, a 25% deposit is required. Amount varies depending on facility rental fee.	Cleanup and damage fee is included in the rental agreement based on expected attendance; cost varies.
Scottsdale Sports Complex	Yes	Yes -Preference is given to Tournaments or events that occupy 2 days.	Balance of tournament fees are due in full 45 working days prior to use.	No deposit for cleanup/damage but customer is billed accordingly for any needed cleanup or damage done; cost varies depending on needs.
Civic Center Mall	Yes	Yes, however -The Mall's own presented programming takes precedence over other events.	No formal "hold" procedure and a deposit isn't required to hold a date. If there is something on hold and another interest is received, the new request the "challenge" the date policy is applied.	Damage/cleanup deposit is 20% of the facility use cost.

City of Glendale	Yes	Yes	Application and \$75 application fee is required to hold date(s). Applications are accepted a year out from event date. Once application is received, the venue is considered reserved.	A 50% deposit for all city services (police, transportation, custodial, EMT, etc) – No deposit for cleanup/damage but customer is billed accordingly for any needed cleanup or damage done; cost varies depending on needs.
City of Tempe	Yes	Yes	Application and \$35 application fee is required to hold a date. Once application is received, the venue is considered reserved.	A deposit of 25% of expected costs of city services (PD, Fire, Solid Waste, etc.) - No deposit for cleanup/damage but customer is billed accordingly for any needed cleanup or damage done; cost varies depending on needs.
City of Phoenix	Yes	Yes	Hold dates vary depending on facility but for city streets the \$400 application fee holds the date unless the applicant cancels request.	No deposit for city services but separate permit fees apply (generator permit, Fire permits etc.) No deposit for cleanup/damage but customer is billed accordingly for any needed cleanup or damage done; cost varies depending on needs.
City of Chandler	Yes and No	There are two different priority systems based on location; All areas outside the Downtown District & Areas within the Downtown District.	An application is required to hold a date. No deposit is required - just full payment after approved. The first completed application gets the date. If another application is received for the same date – applicant gets placed on a waiting list until the event is approved.	Deposits are not always required but can be required at the discretion of the special events committee.
