Review fee	\$75 (is currently \$87)
Simple permit	\$25 (is currently \$105)
Standard permit	\$175 (is currently \$159)
<u>EVENT VENUE FEES</u>	<u>PROPOSED DAILY FEE</u>
Marshall Way Bridge or Stetson Plaza (12,600 sf) without Trolley Access	\$600 for either bridge or plaza \$1200 for both
Marshall Way Bridge or Stetson Plaza (5,200 SF) With Trolley Access	\$250 for either bridge or plaza \$500 for both
Soleri Plaza (6,000 SF) IF DESIRED, USE OF SOLERI BRIDGE IS INCLUDED	\$300
Main Street Plaza (7,100 SF)	\$100
Horseshoe Falls (4,400 SF)	\$100
<p>Note: Proposed daily fee does not include SRP license fees, city or SRP insurance requirements, or any additional requirements for fencing, restrooms, security, large tents, etc. Event Venue Use fees would be discounted by 25% for events held entirely within May, June, July, August or September.</p>	
<u>STREET FEES</u>	<u>PROPOSED DAILY FEE</u>
Arterial streets	\$200 per lane, per mile
Collector streets	\$100 per lane, per mile
Local streets	\$100 per full street segment up to one mile (no charge for city-registered Neighborhood Watch groups (for block parties))
<u>DOWNTOWN FEES</u>	<u>PROPOSED DAILY FEE</u>
Downtown arterial, collector and couplet streets	\$500 up to first 1/4 mile (includes both directions, street + parking with sidewalk open); \$375 each additional 1/4 mile
Downtown local streets	<p>\$250 up to first 1/4 mile (includes both directions, street + parking with sidewalk open) for events that are free and open to the public with unrestricted access; \$175 each additional 1/4 mile</p> <p>-----</p> <p>\$400 up to first 1/4 mile (includes both directions, street + parking with sidewalk open) for events that have restrictions and/or limit public access (such as charge admission, age restrictions, etc.); \$300 each additional 1/4 mile.</p>

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<u>DOWNTOWN FEES</u>	<u>PROPOSED DAILY FEE</u>
City off-street parking lots and garages	\$0.0125 per sf (open to public) (20,000 sf would be \$250) \$0.025 per sf (closed to public) (20,000 sf would be \$500)
On-street parking (per space) Parking spaces adjacent to businesses or establishments	\$60 per space
Use of City Restrooms (If portable restrooms not provided)	\$250 City's contracted cost for service
<u>OTHER FEES</u>	<u>PROPOSED DAILY FEE</u>
Sidewalk	\$50 per closed segment, one block or less
Other public property not identified (such as an alley, plaza, or off-street parking closure)	\$.40 cost per square foot (250 sf = \$100)
