1. November 6, 2018 Special Election for the Issuance and Sale of General Obligation Bonds
Request: Adopt Resolution No. 11092 ordering and calling a special election for Tuesday,
November 6, 2018, to submit to the qualified electors of the City of Scottsdale a question authorizing
the issuance and sale of \$350,000,000 principal amount of general obligation bonds.

- City Engineer Dave Lipinski presentation.
- Councilman Smith made a motion to amend the \$350 million package to add the Scottsdale Stadium Renovation Project, in an amount sufficient to cover 50% of the estimated cost of the project, for a total bond package of \$380 million. Councilwoman Milhaven seconded the motion. No vote taken.
- Councilman Phillips made an alternate motion to defer the bond election until 2020 and agendize for a future meeting a presentation, discussion, and possible action on a .15% sales tax increase for transportation. Councilwoman Littlefield seconded the motion, which carried 4/3, with Vice Mayor Korte and Councilmembers Milhaven and Smith dissenting.
- Councilwoman Milhaven made a motion to agendize, for the same meeting that the sales tax discussion will occur, consideration of placing a bond election on the November 2018 ballot. Vice Mayor Korte seconded the motion which carried 4/3, with Councilmembers Klapp, Littlefield, and Phillips dissenting.
