

## EARLY BALLOT ALTERNATE (TEMPORARY) MAILING ADDRESS REQUEST

The U.S. Postal Service cannot automatically forward ballots to another address. If you will be out of town in the summer and would like to receive an early ballot for Scottsdale's Primary Election (August 28, 2018), you must register your alternate (temporary) mailing address with Maricopa County Elections.
