

Consumer Fireworks Regulations

Arizona Revised Statutes section 36-1601, et al.

**The USE of permissible consumer fireworks as defined under state law is allowed:
June 24 - July 6 and December 24 - January 3**

**The SALE of permissible consumer fireworks as defined under state law is allowed:
May 20 - July 6 and December 10 - January 3**

**All other fireworks are prohibited,
except as authorized by local fire department permit.**

The sale and use of novelties known as snappers (pop-its), party poppers, glow worms, snakes, toy smoke devices and sparklers are permitted at all times.

**Permissible consumer fireworks may not be sold to persons
under sixteen years of age.**

**Check with your local fire department for additional regulations
and dates before using.**

**The USE of Consumer Fireworks is PROHIBITED
ON OR WITHIN ONE MILE of any PRESERVATION LANDS.**
