In examining the statistical data for 2014, 6% of all formal complaints investigated by Internal Affairs came from a citizen or an outside source, whereas 94% of all formal Internal Affairs Investigations were generated within the organization. Internal Affairs logs every citizen complaint, including walk-ins, phone calls, e-mails, letters and faxes. Informal investigations of external citizen complaints are not assigned an IA number and are comprised of allegations that are minor in nature or immediately determined to be unfounded.

Additional Comments:

- 11,163 Custodial Arrests (Decreased 3.33% from 2013)
- 942 Uses of Force in 519 Incidents involving Use of Force (4.6% of all custodial arrests)
- 7 Excessive Force Complaints (None of which were Sustained)
  - 6 were external complaints – All Unfounded
  - 1 was an internal complaint – Unfounded
