



Does the IRS Owe Money to YOU or Someone You Know?

The AARP Tax-Aide program is available to help individuals, families and elderly taxpayers of low to moderate income prepare and file their income tax returns - free of charge. Taxpayers are reminded to bring last year's return, the amount of *Stimulus Payment* received and documentation of the real estate taxes paid.

Here are some important IRS tax credits and benefits that you may qualify for:

- Earned Income Tax Credit May give you a refund if you are a low to moderate income worker
- *Child Tax Credit* May reduce your tax and provide a credit for each child younger than 17
- *Child and Dependent Care Credit* May be able to claim the credit you pay someone to care for your child younger than 13 so that you can work or look for work
- *Education Tax Credit* May help you offset the cost of higher education by reducing income tax
- *Real Estate Taxes* New tax laws allow the deduction of real estate taxes even when the taxpayer takes the standard deduction.

Find out if you are entitled to any refunds this year, including a property tax credit. Tax volunteers will help you prepare federal and state income taxes at no charge. Electronic filing is available at each site.
