

**PROJECT DETAILS
GENERAL FUNDS
RECOMMENDED FOR FY 2016-2017 FUNDING**

GENERAL FUNDS - \$200,000

Alzheimer's Association Desert Southwest Chapter – Scottsdale Alzheimer's Support Program - \$10,000

Through the Scottsdale Alzheimer's Support Program approximately 400 households will receive family care consultation, attend support groups and education workshops, and receive assistance through the helpline.

Catholic Charities Community Services, Inc. – My Sister's Place - \$30,000

Approximately 8 victims of domestic violence will receive shelter (bed nights) and supportive services.

Chrysalis Shelter for Victims of Domestic Violence – Transitional Housing - \$9,000

100% of utility costs to house approximately 25 individuals who are victims of domestic violence will be paid through the Transitional Housing Program. These individuals will be provided transitional housing and supportive services, at a confidential location in Scottsdale.

Community Legal Services, Inc. – Strategic Legal Advocacy for Low-Income Scottsdale Residents- \$18,000

Community Legal Services will provide approximately 630 hours of legal assistance to 30 Scottsdale residents to assist in resolving civil legal problems.

Duet: Partners in Health & Aging – Promoting Aging in Place in Scottsdale Through Transportation and In-Home Services - \$21,000

Approximately 175 homebound elderly or persons with disabilities will receive transportation to medical appointments, grocery shopping, home visits and assistance with paperwork to enable them to remain living in their own homes.

Family Promise Greater Phoenix – Family Promise Emergency Shelter Program - \$30,000

Through the Emergency Shelter Program 350 homeless families will be provided a total of 12,000 bed nights and will receive case management and counseling services. Funding will support transportation costs to/from host congregations and activities.

Jewish Family & Children's Service (JFCS) – JFCS Older Adults In-Home Program - \$25,000

Through the Older Adults In-Home Program, approximately 74 elderly and disabled residents will be provided a total of 830 hours of in-home assessment, case management, counseling advocacy and referral to appropriate resources throughout Maricopa County.

Tumbleweed Center for Youth Development – Community Supported Living Program, Scottsdale Initiative - \$21,000

Transitional apartments will be provided for 6 homeless youth in Scottsdale. Youth will attend weekly life skill workshops, develop individualized self-sufficiency plans and receive weekly case management and community resources and support.

UMOM New Day Centers, Inc. – Regional Shelter Services - \$25,000

Approximately 1,762 homeless persons with basic needs such as food, medical care, childcare, educational programs for youth, vocational training, job preparation, and substance abuse assistance.

Valley of the Sun YMCA – Desert Foothills Family YMCA & Scottsdale/Paradise Valley YMCA – Active Older Adults – Transportation Services - \$11,000

Approximately 200 seniors will be provided transportation to and from the YMCA facilities and offsite events and programs.
