

**PROJECT DETAILS
SCOTTSDALE CARES
RECOMMENDED FOR FY 2016-2017 FUNDING**

SCOTTSDALE CARES - \$100,000

Aid to Adoption of Special Kids (AASK) – AASK Mentoring Program - \$9,000

The Special Friends Mentoring Program will provide training and support to approximately 15 Scottsdale mentors and match foster youth with adult mentors.

Alzheimer’s Association Desert Southwest Chapter – Scottsdale Alzheimer’s Support Program - \$15,000

Through the Scottsdale Alzheimer’s Support Program approximately 600 individuals will be provided with family care consultation, support groups, education workshops, and assistance through the helpline.

Arizona Helping Hands, Inc. – Helping Hands for Foster Kids - \$6,750

Approximately 57 foster children will be provided with basic needs including a bed or a crib, mattress, linens, box springs, high chair and diapers.

Big Brothers Big Sisters of Central Arizona (BBBSAZ) – Pueblo Elementary Site-Based Mentoring Program - \$5,000

Approximately 20 low-income, at-risk youth will be provided with adult mentors, will receive weekly mentoring, and will participate in academic, athletic, and enrichment activities.

Boys and Girls Club of Greater Scottsdale – Operation Outreach - \$15,000

Through the Operation Outreach Program approximately 400 low-income youth and teens will be provided after school and summer activities and site-based mentoring.

Community Bridges, Inc. (CBI) – Mobile Community Outreach and Crisis Stabilization Services - \$15,000

Crisis stabilization services including mobile community outreach and peer support will be provided to approximately 397 Scottsdale adults.

Family Promise Greater Phoenix – Family Promise Emergency Shelter Program – \$14,250

Through the Emergency Shelter Program approximately 350 homeless families will be provided a total of 14,000 bed nights and approximately 120 individuals will receive cases management and counseling services.

Scottsdale Training and Rehabilitation Services (STARS) – STARS’ Cholla Employment Services and Work Center - \$15,000

Approximately 70 disabled individuals will be provided with job assessment, placement services and on-going job coaching and supervision.

Shoebox Ministry – Toiletries for the Homeless and Working Poor - \$5,000

Approximately 253 homeless individuals will be provided personal hygiene toiletry kits and/or under garments.
