

## **Painting Supply List for Oils, Acrylics, Watercolors and Mixed Media**

Suggested Basic oils and acrylic paint colors (color names are the same):

White Titanium, (large tube), Cadmium Yellow Medium, Yellow Ochre, Cadmium Red Light, Alizarin Crimson, Cadmium Orange, Burnt Sienna, , Ultramarine Blue, Sap Green, Ivory Black, Permanent Green Light. Any other colors you prefer.

Medium for oils is Liquin or your choice: medium for acrylics is water. Water container(s).

“Gamsol “ 100% Odorless Mineral Spirits for oils.

Sketch artist canvas or canvas boards.

Palette and/or palette papers or freezer paper.

Paper towels or paint rags.

Palette knife for mixing or painting.

Brushes: White bristle brushes in a variety of sizes. Synthetic hair brushes are best when using oils or acrylics.

Sketch book, pencil, pen, kneaded eraser.

Apron to protect clothing.

Soap for cleaning brushes.

## **Paintings Supply List for Watercolors**

Cold press watercolor paper: singles or pad.

Drawing pencils or watercolor pencils.

Two containers for water.

Artist/blue masking tape.

Palette to hold paints. Hard surface board.

Suggested basic paints (tubes or liquid): Cadmium Red, Cadmium Yellow, Paynes Grey, Sap Green, Burnt Sienna, Ultramarine Blue, White Gauche. Any other colors you have or want to include.

Paper towels. Spray bottle for water.

Watercolor brushes.

I will introduce additional supplies to experiment with as the class proceeds and as I become familiar with your wants, desires, and expectations. We can discuss

this at our first class meeting. Please bring some ideas and resources that you are interested in painting or ask me for suggestions if you need help. I look forward to our time together on this creative journey.
