



The city of Scottsdale is providing a FREE Downtown perimeter trolley route for "Super Bowl" week (starting Monday, Jan. 28, 2008 and running through Sunday, February 3, 2008). The Downtown perimeter trolley route will replace the current trolley route for this week only and will provide extended service until 3 a.m. on Friday, February 1 and Saturday, February 2, 2008 when many of the Super Bowl related events are occurring.

The perimeter route provides easy access/drop off points for hotel shuttles to connect with the trolley. The map also identifies four park-n-ride perimeter lots for visitors who are using rental cars to access the Downtown. The park-n-ride lots will help reduce congestion in downtown and make it more convenient for visitors who are not familiar with the

downtown area. In addition, the map identifies the larger Downtown public parking facilities, which include the recently opened Southbridge underground garage and the Main Street Plaza underground garage.

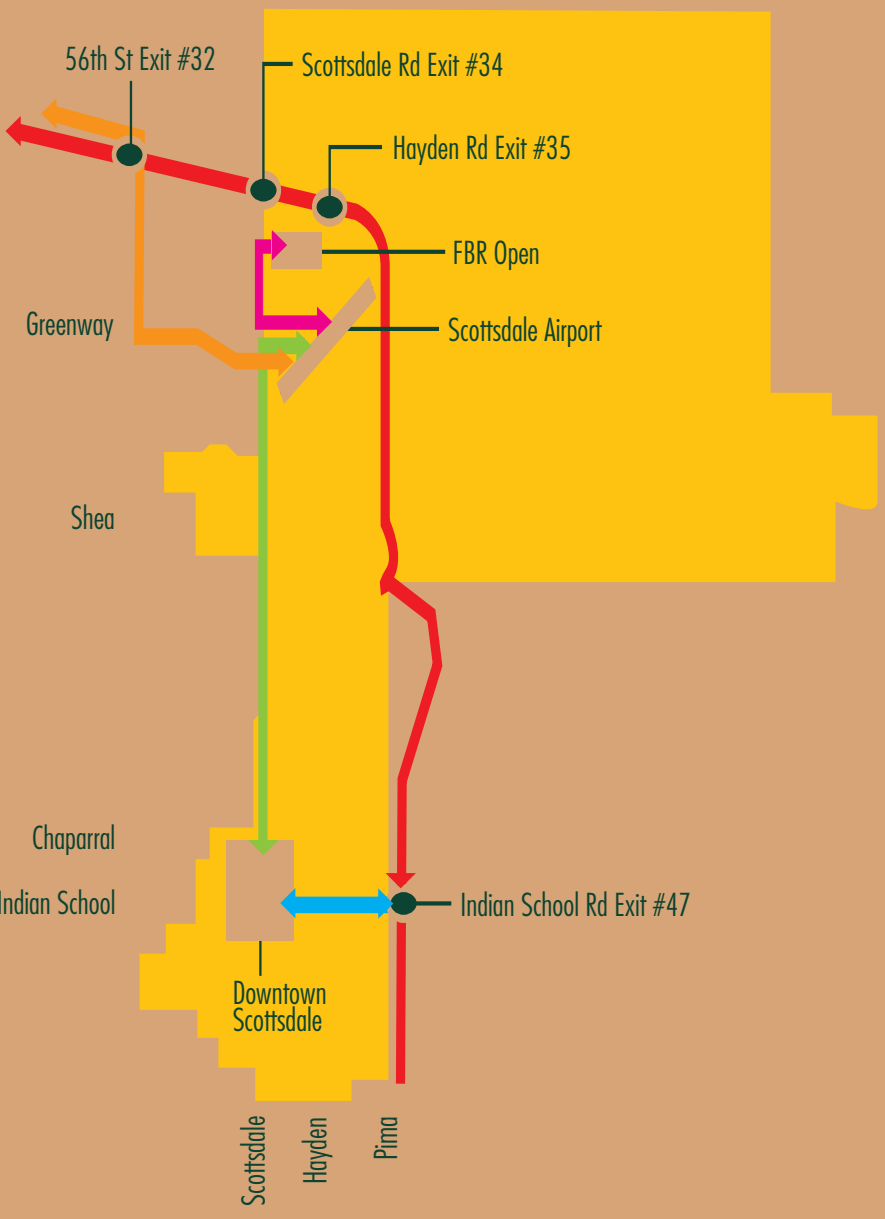
