

ORDINANCE NO. 3847

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SCOTTSDALE, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AMENDING CHAPTER 47, SECTION 47-1, PUBLIC WORKS STANDARDS ADOPTION, RELATING TO (1) ADOPTION OF CURRENT MARICOPA ASSOCIATION OF GOVERNMENTS STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS AND DETAILS, AND (2) SCOTTSDALE SUPPLEMENT TO CURRENT MAG STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS AND DETAILS.

The Maricopa Association of Governments (MAG) has updated its standard specifications and details; and

The City of Scottsdale has been using the MAG Standard Specifications as amended; and

The City of Scottsdale wishes to adopt the MAG Standard Specifications and Details dated 1998 (including revisions through 2009), and

The City of Scottsdale has been supplementing the MAG Standard Specifications and Details for a number of years; and

The City Standards and Specification Committee has recently suggested supplements to MAG Standard Specifications and Details for Public Works Construction within the City of Scottsdale.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Scottsdale as follows:

Section 1. That certain document entitled the "UNIFORM STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS AND DETAILS FOR PUBLIC WORKS CONSTRUCTION, Sponsored and Distributed by the Maricopa Association of Governments, 1998, Arizona (Includes Revisions Through 2009)", three copies of which are on file in the office of the City Clerk, which document was made public record by Resolution No. 7942 of the City of Scottsdale, Arizona, is hereby referred to, adopted and made a part hereof as if fully set out in this ordinance, the provisions thereof to become effective on the 2nd day of July, 2009.

Section 2. That certain document entitled "CITY OF SCOTTSDALE 2009 SUPPLEMENT TO MAG UNIFORM STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS AND DETAILS FOR PUBLIC WORKS CONSTRUCTION", three copies of which are on file in the office of the City Clerk, which document was made public record by Resolution No. 7943 of the City of Scottsdale, Arizona, is hereby referred to, adopted and made part hereof as if fully set out in this ordinance, the provisions thereof to become effective on the 2nd day of July, 2009.

Section 3. Chapter 47 Streets, Sidewalks and Public Works Generally, Section 47-1 Public Works Standards Adoption, is hereby amended as follows:

Sec. 47-1. Public Works Standards Adoption.

- (a) The following documents have been adopted by reference and shall be the standards and details for public works construction in the City of Scottsdale:
- (1) The Uniform Standard Specifications and Details for Public Works Construction, sponsored and distributed by the Maricopa Association of Governments, dated 1998 (includes Revisions through 2009), three (3) copies of which are on file in the office of the City Clerk, which document was made a public record by Resolution No. 7942 of the City of Scottsdale, Arizona, is hereby referred to, adopted, and made a part hereof as if fully set out in this ordinance.
 - (2) The City of Scottsdale 2009 supplement to MAG Uniform Standard Specifications and Details for Public Works Construction, three (3) copies of which are on file in the office of the City Clerk, which document was made a public record by Resolution No. 7943 of the City of Scottsdale, Arizona, is hereby referred to, adopted and made part hereof as if fully set out in this ordinance.
- (b) No person shall violate any of the provisions of the publications adopted in subsection (a), above.

Section 4. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance or any part of the Code adopted herein by reference are hereby repealed, effective as of the 2nd day of July, 2009.


Section 5. The amendment of the Code of the City of Scottsdale does not affect the rights and duties that matured or penalties that were incurred and proceedings that were begun before the effective date of this amendment.
