

ORDINANCE NO. 3866

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SCOTTSDALE, ARIZONA, AMENDING THE SCOTTSDALE REVISED CODE TO ADD SECTION 2-6, ESTABLISHING THE NUMBER OF SIGNATURES REQUIRED FOR SCOTTSDALE MAYORAL AND COUNCIL CANDIDATE NOMINATION PETITIONS.

WHEREAS, Arizona Revised Statutes § 16-322(A)(8) establishes the minimum number of signatures required on an at large city candidate's nomination petitions to be at least five percent and not more than ten percent of the vote in the city; and

WHEREAS, Arizona Revised Statutes § 16-322(A)(8) also provides that a city holding nonpartisan elections may by ordinance establish the minimum number of signatures to be one thousand signatures or five percent of the vote in the city, whichever is less, but not more than ten percent of the vote in the city; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that it is necessary and appropriate to add Section 2-6 of the Scottsdale Revised Code to establish the number of signatures required for Scottsdale mayoral and council candidate nomination petitions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Scottsdale as follows:


Section 1. The Scottsdale Revised Code is hereby amended to add the following:

Sec. 2-6. Number of signatures required for mayoral and council candidate nomination petitions.


The minimum number of nomination petition signatures required for a candidate for the office of mayor or council to have his or her name included on the Scottsdale municipal election ballot shall be one thousand signatures or five percent of the vote in the city, whichever is less, but not more than ten percent of the vote in the city.
