1. **Welcome and Introductions.**

CO-CHAIR PHIL RICCIO WAS ABSENT. SGT. QUMYINTEWA LED THE MEETING AND THANKED ALL FOR ATTENDING. BRENT STOCKWELL PROVIDED AN UPDATE ON A RECENT DEPT. OF JUSTICE CONFERENCE HE ATTENDED AS WELL AS THE METH360 PRESENTATION HE ATTENDED.

2. **Review of Crime Impact Subcommittee Goals and Tasks.**

SGT. QUMYINTEWA REVIEWED THE LIST SO THAT ATTENDEES COULD PROVIDE UPDATES ON VARIOUS AREAS.

Goal: Reduce the opportunities for meth users to commit identity theft, fraud and burglary.

Project 1. Create educational collateral material with "10 things you can do" to protect yourself from identity theft, fraud and burglary. (Completed Summer 2007) **BRUCE WALL REPORTED THAT HE IS WORKING ON A REVISION FOR JANUARY 2008. THIS INFORMATION HAS BEEN SHARED THROUGH A VARIETY OF OUTREACH MEDIUMS AND HE REGULARLY FIELDS CALLS WITH QUESTIONS ABOUT THE INFORMATION, WHICH HAS PROVIDED HIM WITH IDEAS FOR UPDATING THE DOCUMENT. HE WILL SHARE THIS WITH THE SUBCOMMITTEE AT THE JANUARY MEETING.**

Project 2. Sponsor six shredding events throughout the Coalition communities (in progress, two completed to date). **KATIE DECKER REPORTED ON THE SUCCESSFUL NOV. 17 EVENT IN FOUNTAIN HILLS. THEY HAD SUCH A GREAT ATTENDANCE THEY HAD TO STOP AN HOUR EARLY. THEY ARE GOING TO HOLD ANOTHER EVENT IN APRIL. THEY ARE ALSO WORKING ON A DATA DESTRUCTION/ELECTRONICS RECYCLING EVENT ON JAN. 5. SHE WILL REPORT BACK AT THE JANUARY MEETING TO TALK ABOUT WHETHER THIS IS A WORTHY PROJECT FOR THE SUBCOMMITTEE TO TAKE ON FOR OTHER COMMUNITIES. MORE DISCUSSION WAS HELD UNDER ITEM 4 BELOW.**

Project 3. Identify ways to eliminate the use of casinos for identity theft and fraud by meth users (on hold). **SGT. QUMYINTEWA SHARED THAT HE IS WORKING ON SETTING UP A TRAINING SESSION AT THE FORT MCDOWELL CASINO AND IS ASKING STEPHANIE**

KREILING FROM COMMUNITY BRIDGES (AND THE COALITION'S STEERING COMMITTEE) TO DO THE PRESENTATION.

Project 4. Identify ways to eliminate the use of hotels in Coalition communities for meth parties (on hold – one training session held in Summer 2007). **BRUCE WALL SHARED ABOUT THE TRAINING EVENT ON METH THAT WAS HELD LAST SUMMER. WE WILL WAIT FOR THE CHIEF'S MEETING TO CONSIDER HOLDING ADDITIONAL EVENTS.**

Goal: Engaging the law enforcement chiefs to focus more attention on meth use and specific crimes.

Project 5. Hold meetings with Police Chiefs to discuss how their departments track, manage and prevent ID theft, fraud and burglary related to meth use (in progress). **THIS ITEM WAS DISCUSSED UNDER ITEM 5 BELOW.**

3. Shredding Event Planning

- A. Jan. 26, 2008 – Paradise Valley – OFF. RICK COOKEMBOO FROM PARADISE VALLEY IS WORKING TO SET THIS UP. THE SUBCOMMITTEE WILL BE NOTIFIED WHEN THIS EVENT IS FINALIZED. BRUCE WALL WILL FOLLOW-UP TO SEE IF ANY ASSISTANCE IS NEEDED WITH GETTING THIS EVENT SET-UP. OFF. COOKEMBOO HAS BEEN WORKING WITH SCOTTSDALE OFF. KORY SNEED.**
- B. Salt River – CRAIG THOMAS REPORTED THAT HE IS WORKING WITH SCOTTSDALE PD TO SET UP THIS EVENT AT SCOTTSDALE COMMUNITY COLLEGE BUT THEY ARE STILL WORKING ON GETTING APPROVALS FROM THE COLLEGE. HE WILL NOTIFY EVERYONE WHEN THE EVENT IS FINALIZED.**
- C. Fort McDowell – SGT. QUMYINTEWA DISCUSSED HOLDING AN EVENT AND KATIE DECKER SAID SHE WOULD WORK TO HAVE FOUNTAIN HILLS RESIDENTS ATTEND AS WELL. THEY WILL WORK ON THIS AND REPORT BACK AT THE NEXT MEETING.**
- D. Cave Creek / North Scottsdale – BRUCE WALL WILL FOLLOW-UP WITH SCOTTSDALE OFF. JASON SNEED TO FIND OUT PROGRESS ON GETTING THIS EVENT SET UP ON THE CACTUS SHADOWS CAMPUS SO THAT RESIDENTS FROM CAREFREE, CAVE CREEK AND NORTH SCOTTSDALE CAN ATTEND. GINA DURBIN IS THE CONTACT AT CAVE CREEK USD.**

4. Police Chiefs Meeting

WE ARE LOOKING AT HOLDING THE MEETING AT THE END OF FEBRUARY / EARLY MARCH. THE MEETING WILL BE HOSTED BY THE TOWN OF PARADISE VALLEY AND CHIEF WINTERSTEEN. CHIEF DELMAR OFFERED TO GET A PRESENTATION BY THE COALITION ON THE INDIAN COUNTRY CHIEFS NEXT MEETING ON JAN. 15. CHIEF DELMAR WILL ALSO FOLLOW-UP WITH THE INTERNATIONAL CHIEFS OF POLICE ASSOCIATION TO SEE IF THERE ARE ANY DATA COLLECTION/RECORDING PROTOCOLS RELATING TO METH-RELATED CRIMES THAT CAN BE SHARED AT THE CHIEFS MEETING.
