HIKE RATING SCALE -

- A: 16+ MILES, AND/OR ELEVATION GAIN OF 3000'+**
- B: 8-16 MILES, AND/OR ELEVATION GAIN OF 1500-3000'**
- C: 3-8 MILES, AND/OR ELEVATION GAIN OF 500-1500'**
- D: LESS THAN 3 MILES, AND/OR ELEVATION GAIN OF 500'**
