The ideal candidate will possess a combination of education and job-related experience equal to a minimum of a Bachelor's degree, five years of supervisory experience and seven years of progressively responsible experience in the operation and maintenance of complex wastewater collection, treatment and reclamation systems.

The Water Reclamation Director acts as technical advisor and performs policy-level coordination, advisory and administrative functions relating to the operation and maintenance of Scottsdale's advanced water recycling operations.

The Advanced Water Treatment Plant at the Scottsdale Water Campus is one of the largest and most advanced water recycling facilities in the world. Recognized by the WateReuse Research Foundation and the Australian Water Recycling Centre of Excellence as one of the world's most innovative water purification projects, the AWT produces 20 million gallons a day of ultrapure

water and was the first indirect potable reuse facility in Arizona.



The state-of-the-art facility, which recently marked 20 years of successful operation, has enabled Scottsdale to recharge over 65 billion gallons of water into our area aquifers, safeguarding the city's long-term water supply while ensuring exceptional water quality in our local aquifers. Due in large part to the recharge efforts at the Water Campus, Scottsdale was the first city in Arizona to meet safe yield and has done so every year since 1986.
