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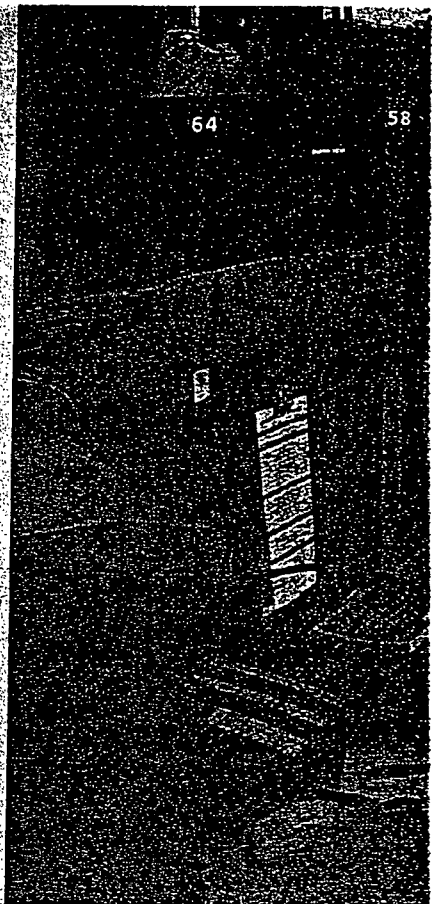

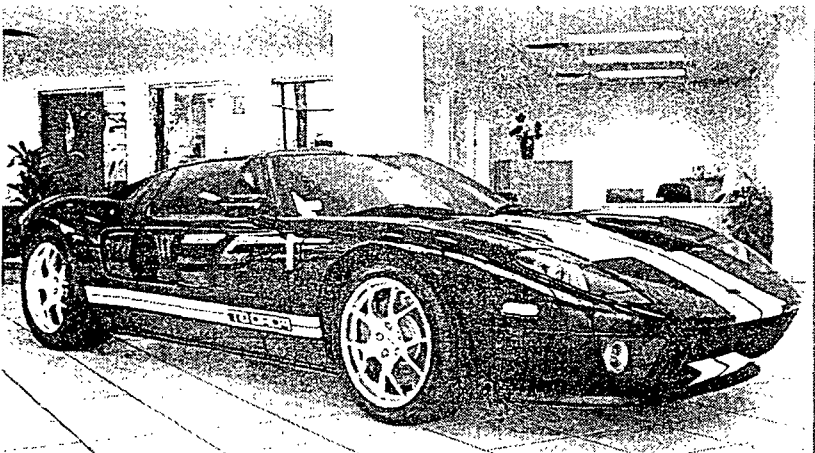

## **Aircraft noise public hearing and workshop scheduled for Jan. 27**

Residents and other community members are invited to attend a public hearing and workshop to provide comments on the update to Scottsdale Airport's Part 150 Noise Compatibility Study.

The open house workshop will provide information on aircraft noise impacts to the surrounding community and recommendations to reduce/manage these impacts now and in the future. The public will also have the opportunity to give oral or written testimony for the public record at the same location.

The public hearing and workshop are being held from 6-8 p.m., on Thursday, Jan. 27, at the Best Western

Scottsdale Airpark Suites, High Flight Rooms, 7515 E. Butherus Drive in Scottsdale. Those interested in providing their input can drop in anytime during the meeting hours. Coffman Associates, Inc., is the airport consultant conducting the study on behalf of the City of Scottsdale. They have studied a range of noise abatement and land use planning alternatives to reduce the impact of aircraft noise near the airport, and have developed their preliminary recommendations and now seek public comment. The preliminary recommendations are divided as follows: 16 Noise Abatement measures, 9 Land Use measures, and 6 Program Management measures. Following the public comment period, recommendations will be made to the Scottsdale City Council for possible adoption and to the Federal Aviation Administration for that agency's approval.

Scottsdale received \$286,590 from the FAA and state to conduct the Noise Compatibility Study. While general aviation airports are not required to conduct noise studies, Scottsdale Airport has been a leader in the area and in the nation as one of the first general aviation airports in the country to submit a Part 150 study. The first Airport Noise Compatibility Study was commissioned by the city in 1985 and the last study was done in 1995.
