

Street Naming and Numbering Committee

Description: At the April 24, 1962 Council Meeting, Tom Felke of the Street Name and Numbering Committee, reviewed the work of the committee. The Committee proposed that the core of Scottsdale retain Scottsdale street numbers and names, and that the rest of the area follow the county metropolitan system of numbering. He explained that the plan and proposed resolution were much like those adopted by Glendale. Subsequently the Council adopted Resolution No. 199 for uniform street names and numbers in the City.

On October 8, 1962, Tom Felke and John La Sota reported that they were appointed to a Street Naming and Numbering Citizen Committee. The purpose of the Committee was to perform a study of street names and numbers because of the rapid growth that created confusion, duplication of names and numbers. There were two numbering systems being used, one in accordance with the metropolitan numbering system, and one with the Scottsdale system.

The committee is first mentioned on April 9, 1957 with the appointments of Raymond Guy and Dave Deahl.

The October 8, 1962 Council minutes state, "Mr. Tom Felke informed that the street naming and numbering citizens' committee, consisting of himself and John LaSota, were appointed to make a study of street names and numbers because of the rapid growth which created much confusion, duplication of names and numbers, and that there were two numbering systems being used, one in accordance with the metropolitan numbering system, starting at Washington; and the other in accordance with the City of Scottsdale, starting at Main Street. He informed that the plan presented met with the approval of the post office, the utility companies, and the Council. He explained that the plan consisted of two zones: the old western downtown area in which they attempted to keep the old street name and numbers where possible. This area is bounded by Canal and Camelback Road on the north; Osborn Road on the south; Cross-cut Canal on the west and Rogers Lane on the east. The outlying area conformed to the street name and numbering in the metropolitan area."

Members of a Street Numbering and Street Naming Committee were named at the June 6, 1967 Council meeting. The minutes of that meeting indicate that the committee was authorized on May 16, 1967, but no information on the creation or authorization of the committee was found.
