**3) Presentation and discussion on solid waste, recycling, and composting

Presentation by Eduardo Rodriguez, Felipe Moreno, Alexis Yaple, and Amanda Jordan, City of Phoenix Public Works Department on how the department is making progress towards achieving its waste diversion objectives of 50% diversion by 2030 and zero waste by 2050 through investments in infrastructure, circular economy initiatives, and education and outreach programs.
