 - <u>COMMISSIONER BROSSEAU REQUESTED A FUTURE AGENDA</u> <u>ITEM TO ALLOW FOR THE COMMISSION TO DISCUSS HOW THE</u> <u>HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION COULD POTENTIALLY</u> <u>RECOGNIZE PROPERTIES THAT DO NOT HAVE HISTORIC</u> <u>DESIGNATION BUT MAINTAIN HISTORIC QUALITIES.</u>

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HISTORIC DESIGNATION.

- <u>COMMISSIONER SHERRIN REQUESTED A FUTURE AGENDA ITEM</u> FOR THE COMMISSION TO RECEIVE A PRESENTATION ON HOW <u>ARCHITECTURAL DETAILS (I.E., WROUGHT IRON SECURITY</u> <u>GATES) BE PRESERVED WITH POSSIBLE CONFLICTS WITH</u> <u>ADOPTED CITY CODES.</u>
- <u>CHAIR DAVIS AND COMMISSIONER LAGE REQUESTED STAFF</u> <u>EXPLORE THE POSSIBILITY OF A JOINT MEETING WITH CITY</u> <u>COUNCIL.</u>
